
There were 249,000 newly reported cases of occupational illness.

Service-providing industries accounted for approximately 53 percent of these cases, while goods-producing industries made up 47 percent.

Manufacturing and health care and social assistance accounted for nearly 61 percent of reported occupational illnesses in 2004.
