Although the rate for days away from work, job transfer, or restriction (DART) in transportation and warehousing fell by 0.3 case to 4.6 cases per 100 full-time workers in 2005, that industry had the highest industry DART rate. Financial activities had the lowest DART rate in 2005.


The DART rate for the total private sector was 2.4 per 100 full-time workers, a decline of 0.1 case per 100 full-time workers from the 2004 figure.

The rate for cases with days away from work was 1.4 per 100 full-time workers, and the rate for cases with job transfer or restriction was 1.0.
