Corridors of the Future Program Southeast High Speed Rail Corridor

Dear Sir:

The purpose of this letter is to transmit, on behalf of the North Carolina Department of Transportation, a corridor proposal for the Corridors of the Future Program (CFP). This corridor proposal responds to the request for applications published in the <u>Federal Register</u> on September 5, 2006.

The Southeast High Speed Rail Corridor (SEHSR) was initially designated by USDOT for future development in 1992, and since that time much has been accomplished among the several states and railroads. The objective of this work effort marries well with the CFP as it addresses congestion through a regional, multi-modal solution. While the primary emphasis to date has been on development of enhanced rail freight and passenger capacity, significant traffic will be diverted from both aviation and highways.

Should this corridor proposal be selected for further development, we will work with all effected parties to gain concurrence.
