# SAFETY POLICY STATEMENT

- It is the policy of Beaver Creek Clearing, Inc. to protect the safety and health of our employees. Injury and Illness losses from accidents are needless, costly and preventable.....
- To accomplish this task, joint worker/supervisor monthly safety meeting and safety training will be provided. Its purpose will be to bring workers/supervisors and management together in a cooperative effort to promote safety in the workplace.

## ■ MANAGEMENT

- Management's responsibility is the prevention of injury, illness and accidents, because management is held accountable for all issues under their control.

## ■ SUPERVISION

- Supervisors are directly responsible for supervising their workers. Supervisors must enforce company rules.

## ■ EMPLOYEES

- Each employee, regardless of their position within the company, is expected to cooperate in all aspects of the company's safety program.

# Employees Must:

- 1. Accidents must be reported immediately to your supervisor.
- 2. Required protective equipment must be worn by all employees, **NO EXCEPTIONS**.
- 3. Hazardous conditions or other safety concerns must be reported to your supervisor immediately.
- 4. Employees must participate in all safety meetings.
- 5. No job is so important that we cannot take time to do it safely.

## ■ SAFETY COMMITTEE


- Develops and Distributes policy, practices and procedures that promote Health and Safety.
- Active Problem Solving Group
  - Identify and control hazards.
  - Helps to resolve health and safety issues.
  - Assemble on a monthly basis.
  - Conducts safety inspections.

- Covers content and location.
