Dear Mr. Fuchs:

As a result of your May 17, 1999 letter regarding your interpretation of the jurisdictional responsibilities of the United States Coast Guard as they relate to your facilities, we contacted Captain P.K. Mitchell, Commander, Group/Marine Safety Office, Long Island Sound, New Haven, CT. His attached written reply, file #16600, dated July 22, 1999 is explicit and self-explanatory.

Accordingly, with reference to our original Letter of Concern, CPF No. 19602C, dated April 2, 1999, we are requesting for the second time, that you provide this office with a "Compliance Plan" as outlined in our previous letter.

If we do not receive your Compliance Plan within thirty (30) days , please be advised that we may determine that it is necessary to initiate enforcement action to be taken in accordance with Part 190, "Pipeline Safety Programs and Rulemaking Procedures", Subpart B - "Enforcement".
