I want to provide you with a status update regarding your April 11, 2005, Request for Reconsideration (RFR #04019A) submitted under the Environmental Protection Agency's Information Quality Guidelines. In the past eighteen months, EPA has taken actions to enhance the objectivity, utility, transparency and integrity of several of the EPA-disseminated models and databases referenced in the Chamber Request for Reconsideration (RFR). Before issuing the final response to the Chamber, the Agency needs to finalize its position on one remaining issue raised in your RFR. We hope to complete our assessment of the feasibility of this additional action within the next ninety days.
