I would like to provide you with a status update regarding your February 3, 2006, Request for Correction submitted under the Environmental Protection Agency's Information Quality Guidelines. These guidelines state that EPA's goal is to respond to each request within 90 days of receipt either by providing a decision on the request or, if the request will require more than 90 days to resolve, informing the requestor that more time is required.

EPA has established a robust process to ensure that each request is thoroughly evaluated and an appropriate response is provided. Due to the complexity of this request, we need additional time to complete this evaluation. We anticipate that a response will be forwarded to you within 90 days, although we do hope that it will be much sooner than that. Thank you for your interest in environmental information quality.
