Dear Mr. Juris:

Thank you for your request for correction under the Environmental Protection Agency's Information Quality Guidelines dated October 21, 2002. Your request was received in this office on October 22, 2002. Following a thorough review, we believe this request does not fall under the Information Quality Guidelines because your request asks EPA to clarify the Plastic Parts Surface Coating Alternative Control Techniques document (EPA-453/R-94-017), rather than requesting correction of information under the Guidelines. Because the correction process under the Guidelines is limited to requests for correction of information disseminated by EPA, the Guidelines correction process does not apply to your request.

While we will not be considering your request under the Information Quality Guidelines, EPA is referring your request to Dave Salman in the Coatings and Consumer Products Group of the Emission Standards Division. He will provide PEA's response to your request. Please note that because your request is not covered by the Guidelines, the Guidelines reconsideration process does not apply.
