Pet First-Aid Kit

- first-aid book
- tweezers
- gauze bandages and pads
- adhesive tape
- scissors
- hydrogen peroxide
- rectal thermometer
- Petroleum jelly
- antibiotic ointment
- cotton swabs

Pet supplies, including:

- plastic pet carrier/crate
- leash
- one-week supply of pet food
- can opener
- any/all regular medications
- water
- bowl for food & water
- blanket and towel
- plastic bags (for pet's waste disposal)
- pet's favorite treats (to entice when scared or stressed)
- disinfectants
- newspapers/paper towels
- comb/brush

Keep in mind...

- current identification ~ ID tags and/or microchip
- current vaccinations will protect your animal against diseases they may contract in a shelter or emergency clinic
- safe sleeping quarters away from windows or under shelving
- a secure yard ~ sturdy fencing with no openings
- two current photos (head and full body shots) to post if your animal is lost
- address/phone numbers of Emergency Clinics
- list of boarding facilities and friends who could temporarily house your pet following a disaster
- written instructions detailing your pet's feeding, exercise and/or medications
- discuss disaster plans in advance with family members and pet sitters
- if you need to evacuate, take your pets
