

6,000 Schools Built and Modernized (\$24.8 billion in School Modernization Bonds)



25,000 Schools Repaired

(Over \$33 billion in loans and grants)

The Republican Alternative:

(Based on the Senate Legislation S. 1134)



Only 198 Schools Built and Modernized

(Expanded benefits for tax-exempt bonds used for school construction)



No Schools Repaired
