

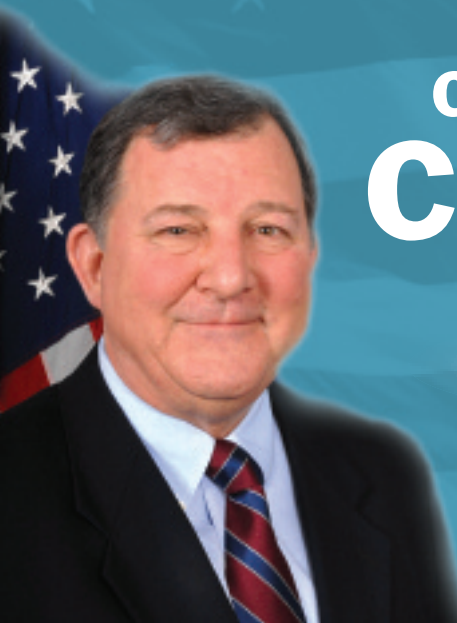

CONTINUED COMMITMENT TO OUR STANDARDS AND VALUES

Congressman Cannon is continuing to aggressively seek congressional support for many of Utah's values and priorities. Congressman Cannon is demonstrating his continued commitment to balancing the budget, protecting rights, and keeping taxes low. Here are just a handful of the proposals he is co-sponsoring in Congress:

- ✓ A balanced budget amendment to the Constitution.
- ✓ An amendment to the Constitution to define marriage as between one man and one woman.
- ✓ A bill to extend the “right to life” in the Constitution to include the unborn.
- ✓ A bill to help rural Utah communities better manage their scarce water resources.
- ✓ The *Second Chance Act* to reduce repeat criminal offenders and make our communities safer.
- ✓ A measure to give the President the line-item veto.
- ✓ An act to give gun owners the right to use their concealed weapon's permit across state lines.
- ✓ Repeal of the Death Tax.
- ✓ A resolution calling on the United Nations Security Council to charge Iranian leader Mahmoud Ahmadinejad with violating the 1948 Convention on the Prevention and Punishment of the Crime of Genocide and United Nations Charter because of his calls for the destruction of the State of Israel.
- ✓ A proposal to have the Department of Homeland Security report to the American people the real-time progress of the border fence.
- ✓ Introduction of the Internet Tax Moratorium that was recently signed into law by the President, keeping Internet access tax free.
