Dear Mr. Commander:

This letter is in reference to a copy of a letter addressed by you to Mr. A. Y. Pandit, Parish of Jefferson, dated 28 June 1990. In your letter to Mr. Pandit you requested permission to deposit material dredged from the 17th Street Canal on the Bucktown Marina Site, Lake Pontchartrain Lakefront Levee.

As I informed you on the phone on 5 July 1990, East Jefferson Levee District has a problem that amounts to almost a total objection and rejection of your plan. The only land or vehicular access to the Bucktown Marina site is via a vehicular ramp permitted to Jefferson Parish and located at BLS 640+34 opposite Carrollton Avenue. This ramp and in effect almost the entire levee section is scheduled to be removed and rebuilt by a Corps of Engineers contract to raise the levee to elevation 16.0 NGVD. The contract for the levee work is scheduled to be awarded in July 1990, and is a 12 month contract. This means that work will probably start some time in Sept. 1990 and be ongoing until September 1991. I do not at this time know the order of work or starting point for the Corps' contractor, but obviously, work on the levee will at some time exclude access to the Bucktown Marina site by truck and for a considerable period of time.

Since access across the levee is at the permit option of East Jefferson Levee District, we would and do object to any permitted activity which would in any way interfere with the levee construction project.

It is possible, however, that after the Corps contract has been awarded and the contractor is known, it may be possible for Boh Brothers to work out a schedule with the Corps' contractor that would allow you to utilize the Bucktown Marina site as a disposal site either before or after construction of the contract reach which includes the vehicle ramp.

East Jefferson Levee District has no objection to the disposal site, but permission to cross the levee is withheld at the present time pending further development of levee construction plans.

You should be aware that disposal of 17th Street Canal material at the Bucktown Marina site is properly under the jurisdiction of 2 permits issued by the Corps of Engineers, copies of neither are in our files. The 2 permits are: Jefferson Parish for permission to fill the Bucktown Marina site and New Orleans Sewerage and Water Board to dredge the 17th St. Canal. The disposal action must comply with the terms of both of these permits and is only peripherly under the jurisdiction of this office.
