SECTION 00800

1. Page 00800-4, paragraph 5.c. (1). Delete this paragraph in its entirety and substitute the following paragraph therefor:

“(1) Access Roads and Staging Areas. The available land based access routes via Metairie Road to the pumping station are as follows:

a. For heavy construction equipment and piling more than 40 feet in length, the available access route is via Metairie Road, to Lake Avenue to the West Side of the pumping station.

b. For the supply of all other construction materials, the available access route is via Metairie Road to Carrollton Avenue to Hyacinth Street to Lake Avenue or Orpheum Avenue to the West Side of the pumping station.

c. Direct land side access to the East Side of the pumping station, through the south side deck over the suction basin of the pumping station is not available.

d. In addition to the requirements stated in Section 02225, paragraph 7.1, the Contractor shall furnish and use manpower and equipment as necessary to continuously keep any public street used free and clean of mud and other debris from his hauling operations. This is necessary to insure safe operation of all vehicles on public streets. The Contractor shall provide truck wash racks, of his own design, prior to entering onto any public street and leaving the work site. The Contractor shall submit his plans for the wash racks to the Contracting Officer for review. No hauling operations shall commence until the truck wash racks have been installed. All trucks used for hauling material shall be pressure washed on the wash racks prior to entering any public road. All truck wash rack wastewater shall be intercepted before draining offsite. At pumping station, the water shall be directed to the parish storm drainage system and the sediment removed and placed within the embankment section. The Contractor shall provide a 12-foot wide aggregate surfaced road between the wash rack and the paved surface. A separator fabric conforming to Section 02245 shall be used underneath the bedding material. Upon completion of the contract, the Contractor shall remove the truck wash racks, aggregate surface road and appurtenances and restore the pumping station access roads to pre-construction conditions. Unless stated elsewhere, no separate measurement or payment will be made for the wash rack. Payment for work covered under this section will be distributed throughout the existing bid items.

2. Page 00800-4, paragraph 5.c.(2). Delete the last sentence in this paragraph and substitute the following: "The Contractor shall be responsible for the preservation of all public and private property, and shall use every precaution necessary to prevent damage thereto. If any direct or indirect damage is done to public or private property by or on account of any act, omission, neglect, or misconduct in the execution of the work on the part of the Contractor, such property shall be restored by the Contractor, at his/her expense, to a condition similar or equal to that existing before the damage was done, or he/she shall make good the damage in another manner acceptable to the Contracting Officer. The Contractor shall notify the Contracting Officer 10 days in advance of the first use of any public street and 30 days in advance of the proposed date of equipment access.

3. Drawing 2-3 of 2-7, Demolition Plan. Add note "Removal of discharge tube end portion is not shown for clarity. For the removal detail, see drawing 6-18 of 6-18."
4. Drawing 7-6 of 7-10, Catch Basin Details. On drawing "Elevation" change the " 6" " vertical measurement for bedding thickness to " 9" ".
