

## Research in Newspapers

To electronically search a database for newspaper stories on your topic, follow these steps.

1: Go to the Electronic Resources link on the UNT-Dallas Library services page.

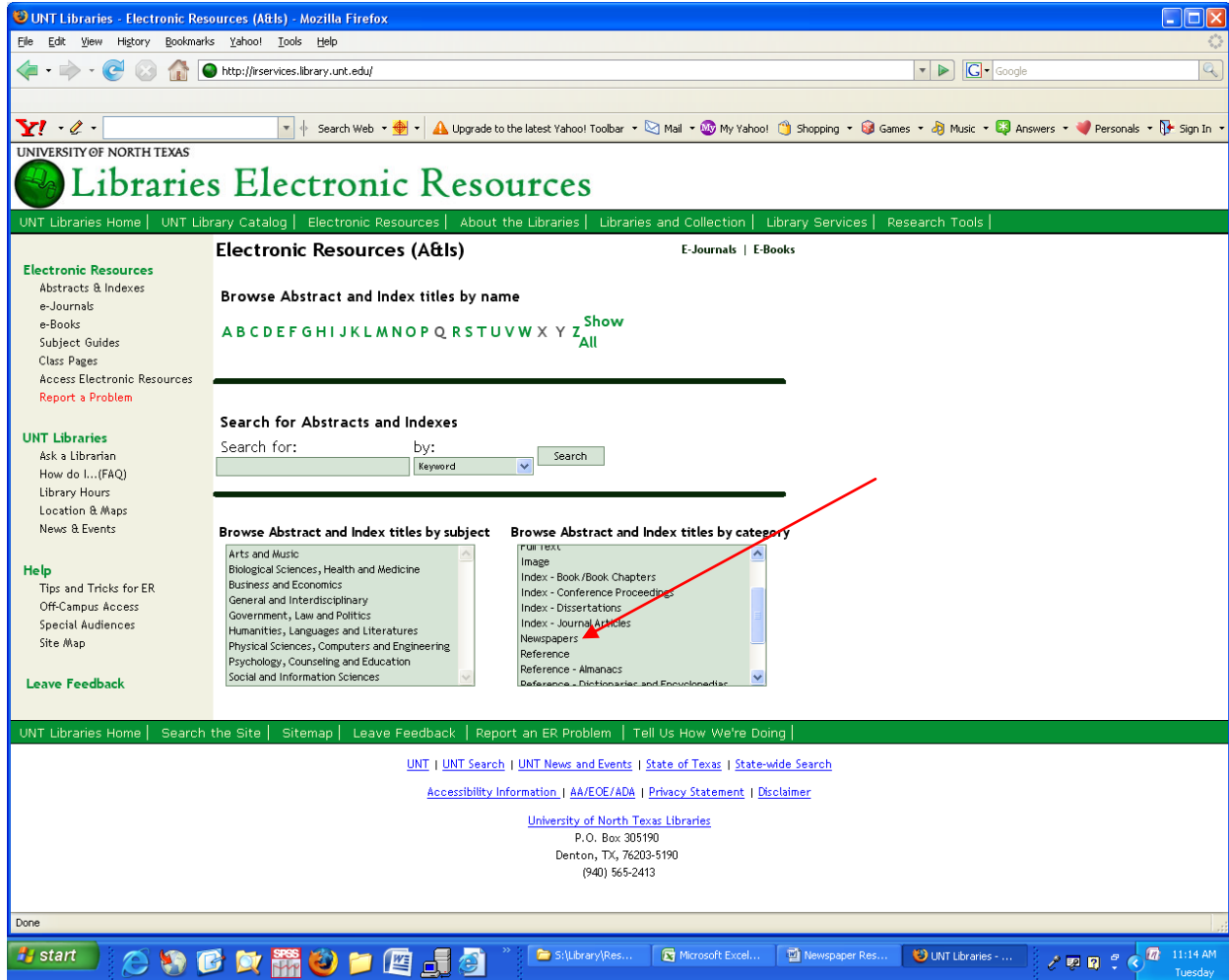

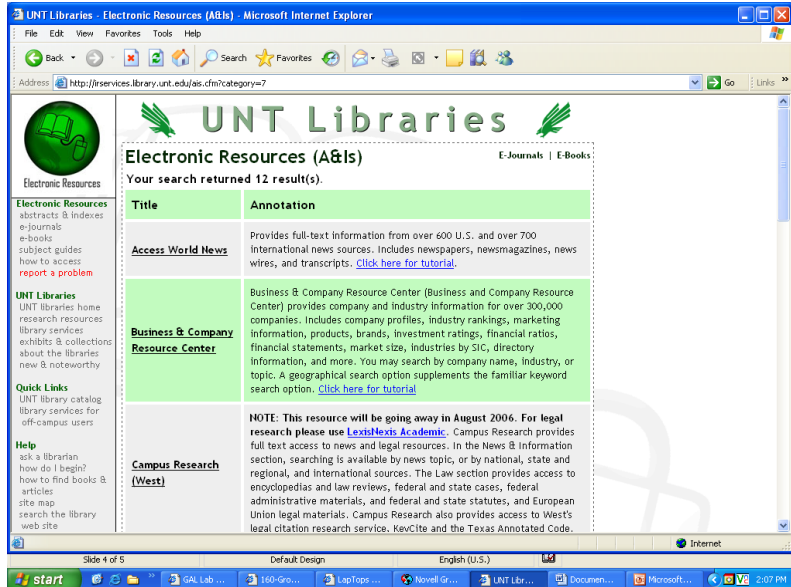

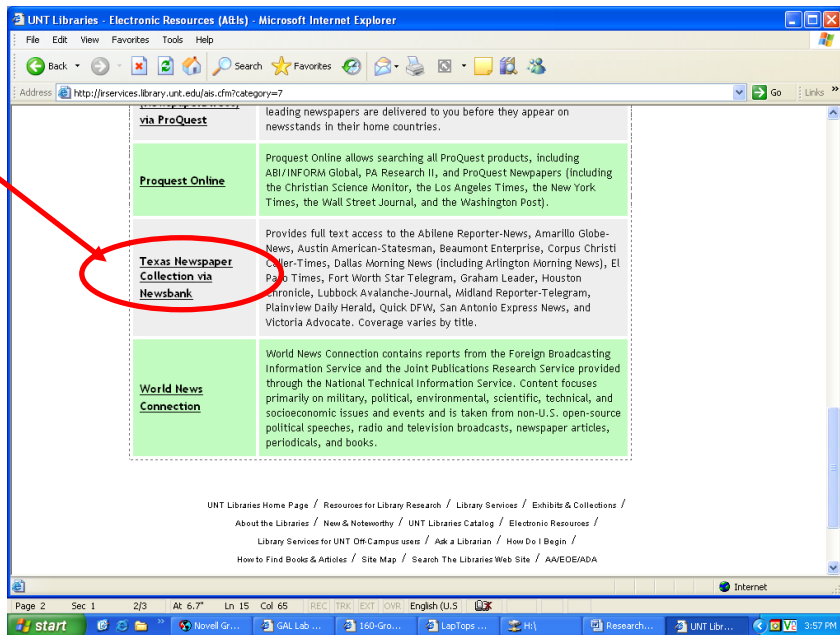
2. Next, scroll down the "Browse Abstract and Index titles by category" box, until you see the category, "Newspapers." Click on that category.



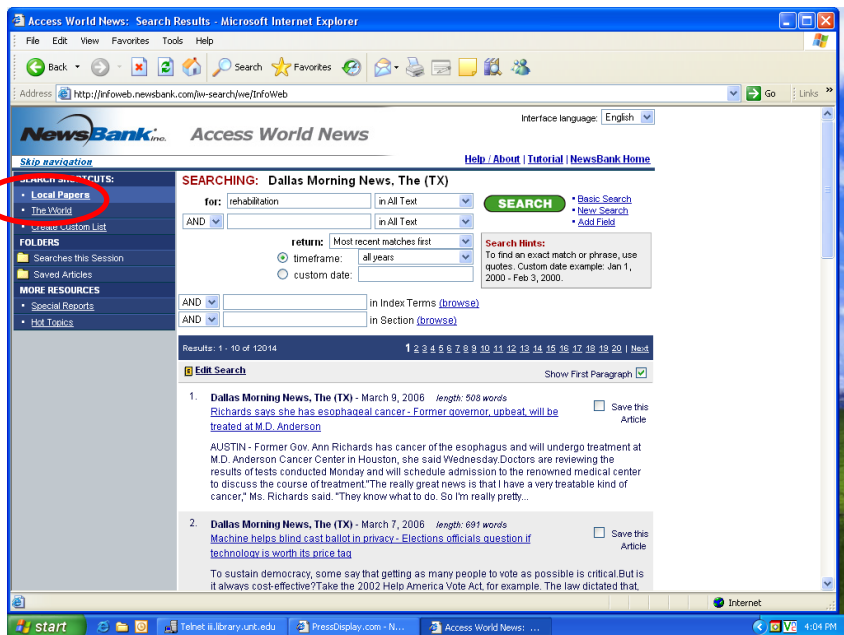
3. You will then be taken to a list of databases that can be used to search newspapers. Read the Annotations to find the subject areas covered by each one.



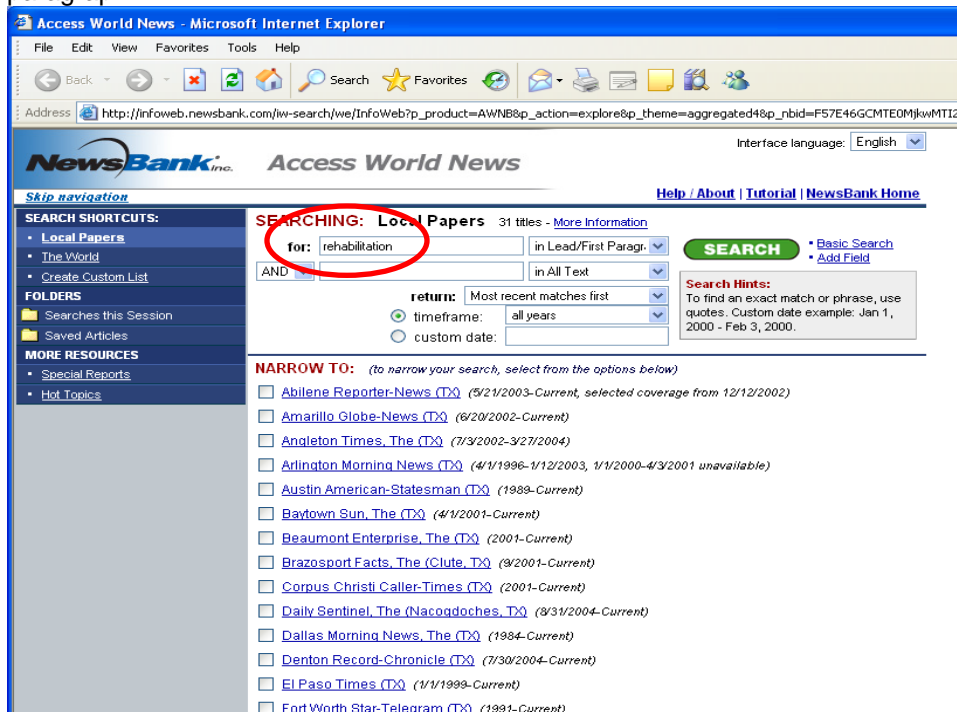
4. To search local newspapers, choose "Texas Newspaper Collection via Newsbank." You will have to scroll down to see it listed.



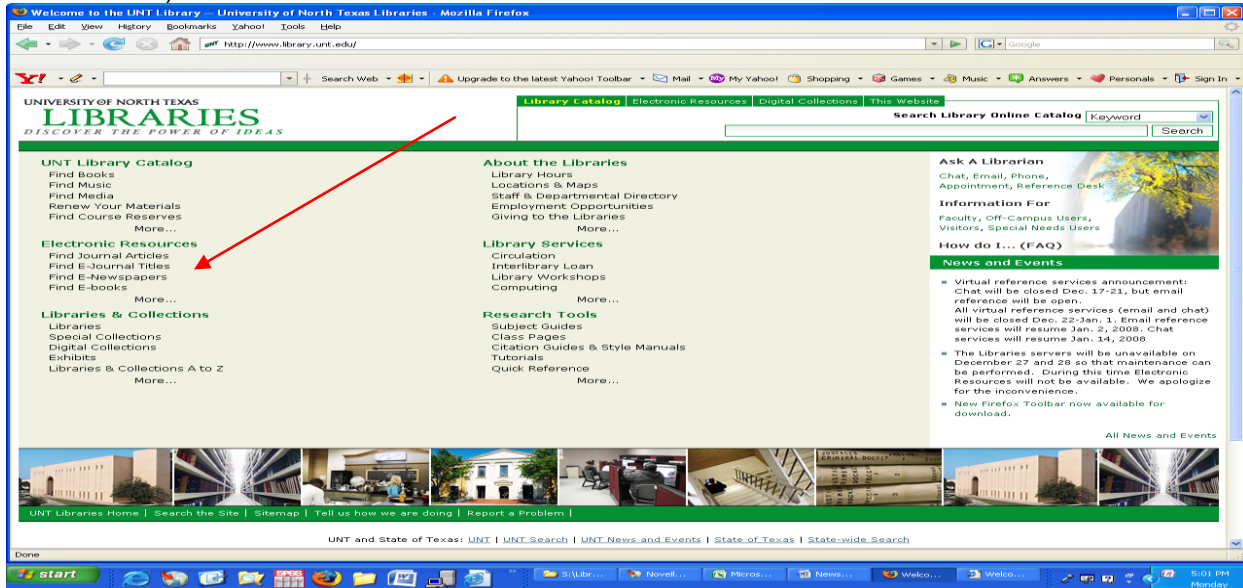
5. Click the "Local Papers" link for a list of the Texas newspapers that will be searched. You have the option of searching more newspapers by clicking "The World" link. This will take you to page where you can browse newspapers by region.



You can search multiple newspapers simultaneously by the topic you are researching. For example: the following search is on all Texas newspapers, for "rehabilitation" in the lead or first paragraph:



To browse today's edition of any of 200 newspapers from 55 countries, go to the UNT Libraries homepage at [www.library.unt.edu](http://www.library.unt.edu), and click on the Electronic Newspapers link, highlighted below. (Just remember that Electronic Newspapers is just like reading the paper. You cannot search for topics with this resource.)



You can browse the newspapers available by county, language, or alphabetically by title. For example, to find the Dallas Morning News, select "D" Alphabetically in the drop down calendar highlighted below.





Then click the letter "D", and browse for the Dallas Morning News in the main window. (You will have to scroll down.)
