U.S. COPYRIGHT OFFICE NEWSNET

NewsNet is the Copyright Office's free electronic mailing list. *NewsNet* issues periodic email messages that alert subscribers to hearings, deadlines for comments, new and proposed regulations, new publications, and other copyright-related subjects of interest. A complete archive of *NewsNet* messages is available at www.copyright.gov/newsnet.

Subscribers may sign up for three topics of information. They are:

- ▶ "What's New at the Copyright Office," which alerts subscribers to general copyright-related news and changes to the Office website
- ▶ "Licensing," which provides updates on regulations and procedures for compulsory and statutory licenses
- ▶ "Legislative Developments," which informs readers about copyright-related bills introduced in Congress or enacted into law

Subscribers may indicate preferences regarding delivery of their messages, including frequency of delivery. They may also suspend delivery until a set date and receive messages through a personalized RSS feed.
