An important message from Medicare for people in

Fraud costs the Medicare Program billions of dollars each year.

Fraud can happen when Medicare gets billed for a drug injection or infusion you didn't get.

Or, fraud can happen when someone uses your Medicare number to bill Medicare without your knowledge.

Take action to help stop Medicare fraud!

- ★ Check your Medicare statements to make sure Medicare isn't charged for infusions or injections you didn't get.
- ★ If you suspect a fraudulent charge on your Medicare statement, call the **Medicare Infusion Fraud Hotline** at **1-866-417-2078**.
