Corps of Engineers at Waco Lake closes parks due to recent rains

FORT WORTH, Texas – The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, Fort Worth District, has temporarily closed several parks at Waco Lake due to recent flooding. Parks closed until further notice are Koehne Park, Midway Park boat ramp, Lacy Point Access Area, Reynolds Creek boat ramp and campsites one thru 22, Flat Rock Access boat ramp, and all marinas.

Visitors can access the lake through other park areas that include Speegleville Campground, Reynolds Creek Park amphitheater and playground sites 23-49, Midway Park campsites, Twin Bridges Park group shelter, Dam Hike and Bike Trail, and Bosque Park.
