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Corps of Engineers schedules Pecan Creek public meeting

Fort Worth, Texas – The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers will host a public meeting Nov. 17 at 6:30 p.m., at the Civic Center, 311 South Weaver Street, Gainesville, Texas. Attendees will be presented an overview of the recommended Pecan Creek project in Cooke County and will be provided an opportunity for public comment. The Draft Detailed Project Report, which includes an integrated Environmental Assessment regarding the proposed implementation of the flood damage reduction project on Pecan Creek, sponsored by the City of Gainesville, is available for review at the following addresses:

The objective of the study was to examine flood damage reduction alternatives along Pecan Creek and recommend a flood damage reduction project for implementation, if one could be found, that is technically and economically feasible, environmentally acceptable, and supported by the City of Gainesville.
