Corps announces facility closures

FORT WORTH, Texas – The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers has closed the following facilities due to construction activities and drought conditions:

| Canyon Lake – | Sites 34-61 in Potters Creek Park are closed. |
| Benbrook Lake – | All boat ramps are closed except for the Rocky Creek Marina. |
| Lake O' the Pines – | Due to low water conditions, the following ramps have become unusable for all but the smallest vessels: Copeland Creek, Mims Chapel and Oak Valley. Use extreme caution when launching at the following ramps: Alley Creek Campground, Alley Creek Day Use, Brushy Creek Day Use (Shady Grove), Cedar Springs, Lone Star and Pine Hill. RV Area II in Johnson Creek Park and a portion of RV Area II in Brushy Creek Park are closed for construction. |
| O.C. Fisher Lake – | All ramps are unusable. |
| Bardwell Lake – | The road below the dam is closed until further notice. |
| Waco Lake – | Airport Park closed. All other parks open. |
| Wright Patman Lake – | Malden Lake Park is closed until Sept. 2, 2005 for construction activities. |

Corps officials remind all visitors to follow safe water and boating practices.
