# PUBLIC NOTICE

The District Engineer has received a permit application from the applicant shown below requesting a change to a previously authorized golf course. This golf course was built. However, it will now be converted to a residential subdivision as described below. This change in use will require additional impacts to **waters of the United States**. The Corps is soliciting comments on both the project itself and the range of issues to be addressed in the environmental documentation.

## PROPOSED WORK AND PURPOSE

To accomplish this the applicant is requesting authorization to change the permitted use from a golf course to said residential subdivision. The applicant is requesting authorization to place additional fill in approximately 4,109 square feet of wetlands for the construction of road crossings for the development of the new residential subdivision.

The Corps issued a permit June 16, 1998 (permit number 199602336) for the construction of the golf course. This authorized the filling of approximately 0.933 acres and the selective cutting of another approximately 6 acres of wetlands for the construction of an 18-hole golf course. The permit also required the performance of wetland mitigation to offset the lost functions and values from the construction of the Pistol Creek golf course.

The permitted work is described on the enclosed plans entitled "PISTOL CREEK INVESTORS, LLC" on one of one sheet, and dated "July 1997" and "PISTOL CREEK INVESTORS, LLC" on 15 sheets (sheet 1, 2 & 5- 9, 12-15 are dated "August 12, 1997", sheets 3 & 4 are dated "Rev. 10/15/97" and sheets 10-11 dated "Rev. 11/12/97". The mitigation is shown on the enclosed plans entitled "PROPOSED MITIGATION AREAS" on 12 sheets and dated "Rev. 1/8/98".

The proposed subdivision with both the impacts from the golf course and those proposed are shown on the enclosed plans entitled "RIO VISTA/PISTOL CREEK ESTATES" in 11 sheets, and dated "MAY 6, 2007" and "RIO VISTA WETLAND IMPACTS REGULATED ACTIVITY 1" on sheet WI-1A and WI-1B; "WETLAND IMPACTS REGULATED ACTIVITY 2" on sheet WI-2A and WI-2B; "WETLAND IMPACTS REGULATED ACTIVITY 3" on sheet WI-3A and WI-3B; and "WETLAND IMPACTS REGULATED ACTIVITY WI-4A and WI-4B" and dated Jan26, 2006".

The applicant is also proposing to perform additional mitigation. The mitigation is described on the enclosed plans entitled "RIO VISTA, WETLAND MITIGATION ACTIVITY 1" on sheet WM-1-A and WM-1-B; "WETLAND MITIGATION ACTIVITY 2 & 3" on sheets WM-2 & 3-A and "WETLAND MITIGATION ACTIVITY 2 & 3" on sheet WM-2 & 3-B; and "WETLAND CREATION PLANT LIST" on one sheet WM-PL and dated "February 2, 2007".

### **WATERWAY AND LOCATION OF THE PROPOSED WORK**

This work is proposed in the wetlands of Spruce Brook at the intersection Spruce Brook Road, Berlin and Atkins Street, Middletown, Connecticut. The proposed location on the USGS MIDDLETOWN, CT quadrangle sheet is at Latitude 41.604368 and Longitude 72.731802.

### **AUTHORITY**

Permits are required pursuant to:

- Section 10 of the Rivers and Harbors Act of 1899  
 Section 404 of the Clean Water Act  
 Section 103 of the Marine Protection, Research and Sanctuaries Act).

The decision whether to issue a permit will be based on an evaluation of the probable impact of the proposed activity on the public interest. That decision will reflect the national concern for both protection and utilization of important resources. The benefit which may reasonably accrue from the proposal must be balanced against its reasonably foreseeable detriments. All factors which may be relevant to the proposal will be considered, including the cumulative effects thereof; among those are: conservation, economics, aesthetics, general environmental concerns, wetlands, cultural value, fish and wildlife values, flood hazards, flood plain value, land use, navigation, shoreline erosion and accretion, recreation, water supply and conservation, water quality, energy needs, safety, food production and, in general, the needs and welfare of the people.

The Corps of Engineers is soliciting comments from the public; Federal, state, and local agencies and officials; Indian Tribes; and other interested parties in order to consider and evaluate the impacts of this proposed activity. Any comments received will be considered by the Corps of Engineers to determine whether to issue, modify, condition or deny a permit for this proposal. To make this decision, comments are used to assess impacts on endangered species, historic properties, water quality, general environmental effects, and the other public interest factors listed above. Comments are used in the preparation of an Environmental Assessment and/or an Environmental Impact Statement pursuant to the National Environmental Policy Act. Comments are also used to determine the need for a public hearing and to determine the overall public interest of the proposed activity.

Where the activity involves the discharge of dredged or fill material into waters of the United States or the transportation of dredged material for the purpose of disposing it in ocean waters, the evaluation of the impact of the activity in the public interest will also include application of the guidelines promulgated by the Administrator, U.S Environmental Protection Agency, under authority of Section 404(b) of the Clean Water Act, and/or Section 103 of the Marine Protection Research and Sanctuaries Act of 1972 as amended.

## SECTION 106 COORDINATION

Based on his initial review, the District Engineer has determined that the proposed work may impact properties listed in, or eligible for listing in, the National Register of Historic Places. Additional review and consultation to fulfil requirements under Section 106 of the National Historic Preservation Act of 1966, as amended, will be ongoing as part of the permit review process.

## ENDANGERED SPECIES CONSULTATION

The New England District, Army Corps of Engineers has reviewed the list of species protected under the Endangered Species Act of 1973, as amended, which might occur at the proposed project site during the construction and subsequent operation/use period sought by the applicant. We have undertaken a Biological Assessment (BA) of the potential for interactions and adverse impacts to those listed species. It is our determination that the proposed activity for which authorization is being sought is designed, situated or will be operated/used in such a manner that it is not likely to adversely affect any Federally listed endangered or threatened species or their designated critical habitat. By this Public Notice, we are requesting that the appropriate Federal Agency concur with our BA determination.

The following authorizations have been applied for, or have been, or will be obtained:

- ( ) Permit, License or Assent from State.
- (X) Permit from Local Wetland Agency or Conservation Commission.
- (X) Water Quality Certification in accordance with Section 401 of the Clean Water Act.

In order to properly evaluate the proposal, we are seeking public comment. Anyone wishing to comment is encouraged to do so. **Comments should be submitted in writing by the above date.** If you have any questions, please contact Stephen D. DiLorenzo at (978) 318-8373, (800) 343-4789 or (800) 362-4367, if calling from within Massachusetts.

Any person may request, in writing, within the comment period specified in this notice, that a public hearing be held to consider the application. Requests for a public hearing shall specifically state the reasons for holding a public hearing. The Corps holds public hearings for the purpose of obtaining public comments when that is the best means for understanding a wide variety of concerns from a diverse segment of the public.

The initial determinations made herein will be reviewed in light of facts submitted in response to this notice. All comments will be considered a matter of public record. Copies of letters of objection will be forwarded to the applicant who will normally be requested to contact objectors directly in an effort to reach an understanding.



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

4. LIGHTLY MULCH ALL SEDED AREAS WITH WEED-FREE STRAW.
5. NATURAL TOPSOIL USED SHALL CONSIST OF AT LEAST 12% ORGANIC CARBON CONTENT (by weight). MANMADE TOPSOIL, IF USED, SHALL CONSIST OF A MIXTURE OF EQUAL VOLUMES OF ORGANIC AND MINERAL MATERIALS
6. COMMERCIALLY PACKAGED PEAT FROM SEDGE, SPHAGNUM, OR REED SOURCES IS SPECIFICALLY
