1. The Copyright Royalty and Distribution Act of 2004 (Public Law 108-419), effective May 31, 2005, replaced the Copyright Arbitration Royalty Panel system with the Copyright Royalty Judges, who are appointed by the Librarian of Congress.

2. The General Counsel serves as counsel to the Executive Committee.

3. The Library of Congress Inspector Act of 2005, (Public Law 109-55), effective August 2, 2005, replaced authority for conducting independent audits and investigations previously bestowed by the Librarian of Congress.
