

Virgin Islands, 2005

Primary and secondary syphilis

- **CASES:** Virgin Islands reported 1 case in 2005.
- **RATES:** Virgin Islands ranked 42 among 50 states + DC + 3 territories: 0.9 cases per 100,000 population compared to the U.S. rate of 3.0 cases per 100,000 population.

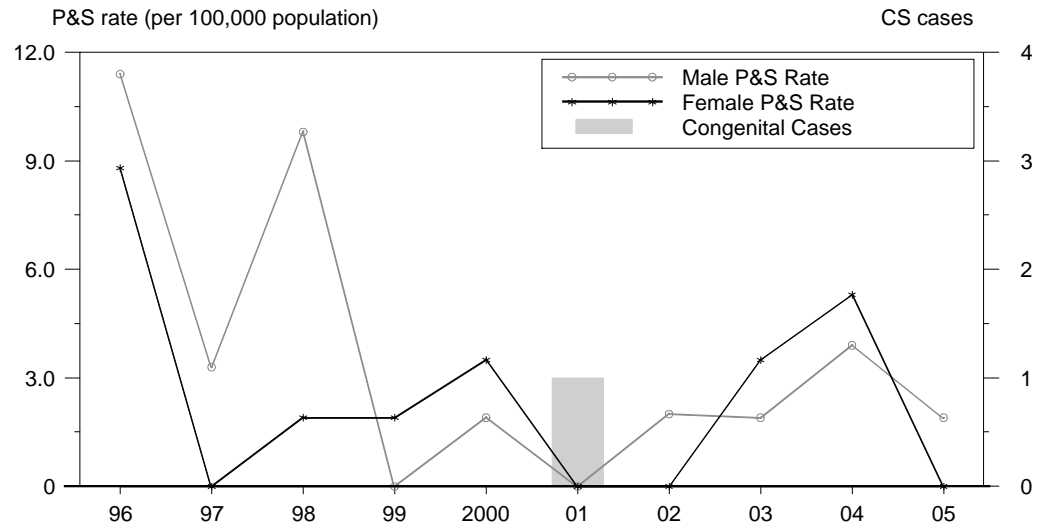
Male-female rates of primary and secondary syphilis

- In Virgin Islands, the rate among males was 1.9 per 100,000 population compared to the U.S. male rate of 5.1 per 100,000.
- The rate among females was 0.0 per 100,000 compared to the U.S. female rate of 0.9 per 100,000.

Congenital syphilis

- **CASES:** Virgin Islands reported 0 cases in 2005.
- **RATES:** Virgin Islands had a rate of 0.0 cases per 100,000 live births compared to the U.S. rate of 8.0 cases per 100,000.
