- a. Inform the affected persons of the benefits available under Public Law 91-646 and the policies and procedures in carrying out the Act and provide payments and services required by Sections 210 and 305 of the Act; and
- b. Within a reasonable time prior to displacement, make available to displaced persons decent, safe and sanitary dwellings; and
- c. In acquiring real property, be guided, to the greatest extent practicable under State law, by the land acquisition policies in Sections 301 and 302 of the Act, and will pay or reimburse property owners for necessary expenses as specified in Sections 303 and 304 of the Act; and

d. Maintain records in accordance with the regulations of the Department of the Army, in connection with the requirements of the Act, for a period of three (3) years after payment of the last voucher for the Project.

- d. Maintain records in accordance with the regulations of the Department of the Army, in connection with the requirements of the Act, for a period of three (3) years after payment of the last voucher for the project.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the President of the said Board be, and is hereby authorized, empowered and directed to execute for and in the name of the said Board, an Act or Acts of Assurance or other instruments wherein the facts set out in the preamble hereof shall be submitted and the said supplemental assurances as aforesaid are furnished to the Secretary of the Army.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Guy F. LeMieux, President of the Board be, and he is further authorized, empowered and directed for and in the name of the said Board to acquire in the name of the Board of Levee Commissioners of the Orleans Levee District

all required lands, easements and rights-of-way, and to grant permission to the United States to enter thereon for the purpose of the improvement as aforesaid, and to execute all deeds or other instruments necessary or desirable and to do any and all acts that may be necessary in making available the said easements and rights-of-way and conveyance thereof to the United States.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that any resolution or resolutions in conflict herewith be and the same are hereby repealed.
