

To the best of my knowledge the proposed activity described in my permit application complies with and will be conducted in a manner that is consistent with the Louisiana Coastal Management Program. Levee Material will consist of silty clay obtained trucked in from a borrow source - Approximate quantity of new levee fill is 9,000 cu. yds. Approximate quantity of re-used levee fill is 10,000 cu. yds. Preliminary plans will be forwarded for your review. Exact sections, construction details, sheet pile wall stability analyses and estimated earthwork quantities will be forwarded to you at the completion of the design phase of this project as they are available.

Project will be discussed at Public Information Meeting to be held July 20, 1983 at 7:00 p.m. City of N.O. Council Chambers, 1300 Perdido Street, New Orleans, LA 70130. Interested parties will be invited to attend. Advertisement will be placed in TP/N.O. States.

15. Application is hereby made for a permit or permits to authorize the activities described herein. These laws require permits authorizing structures and work in or affecting navigable waters of the United States, the discharge of dredged or fill material into waters of the United States, and the transportation of dredged material for the purpose of dumping it into ocean waters. Information provided in ENG Form 4345 will be used in evaluating an application for a permit. Information in the application is made a matter of public record through issuance of a public notice. Disclosure of the information requested is voluntary; however, the data requested are necessary in order to communicate with the applicant and to evaluate the permit application. If necessary information is not provided, the permit application cannot be processed nor can a permit be issued.

A set of original drawings or good reproducible copies which show the location and character of the proposed activity must be attached to this application (see sample drawings and checklist) and be submitted to the District Engineer having jurisdiction over the location of the proposed activity. An application that is not completed in full will be returned.

The proposed activity is the construction of two 1000 cfs pumps which is another phase of the enlargement of S&WB Drainage Pumping Station No. 6 to a total capacity of 10,400 c.f.s. This project will include levee and floodwall relocation and construction as well as an extension westward of the existing Southern Railroad Bridge.
