

# Financial Status Report (FSR) Extramural Release Notes Version 2.2.4.0

## General Update

With this release, the following changes have been instituted within the FSR application.

1. Modifications have been made to handle a different format of the Award Document (APPLS\_T.AWD\_DOC\_NUM) that accommodates both the **Old** and **New** formats.
2. A modification has been made to ensure that the Activity Code is used to obtain unique Application\_ID in relations between FSRs.
3. New grant selection rules for foreign grants have been implemented.

## FSR Edit Screen (FSR8005)

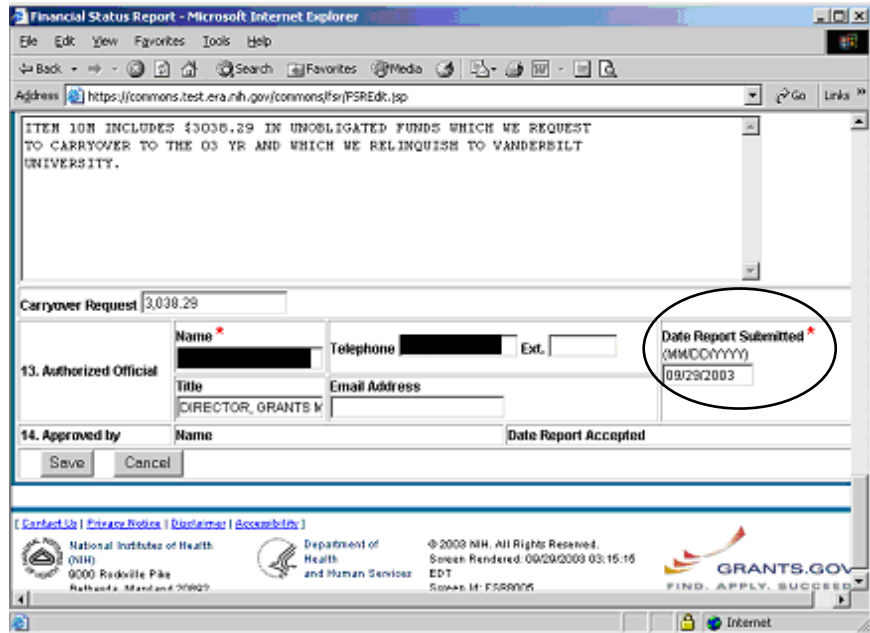


Figure 1. 2 FSR Edit Screen (FSR8005).

1. As illustrated in Figure 1. 1, the field name Prior Unexpended Balance has been changed to **Unexpended Balance from Prior Project Period**.

- As illustrated in Figure 1. 2, the **Date Report Submitted** field now defaults to the system date when OFM and OFMDE users make edits.

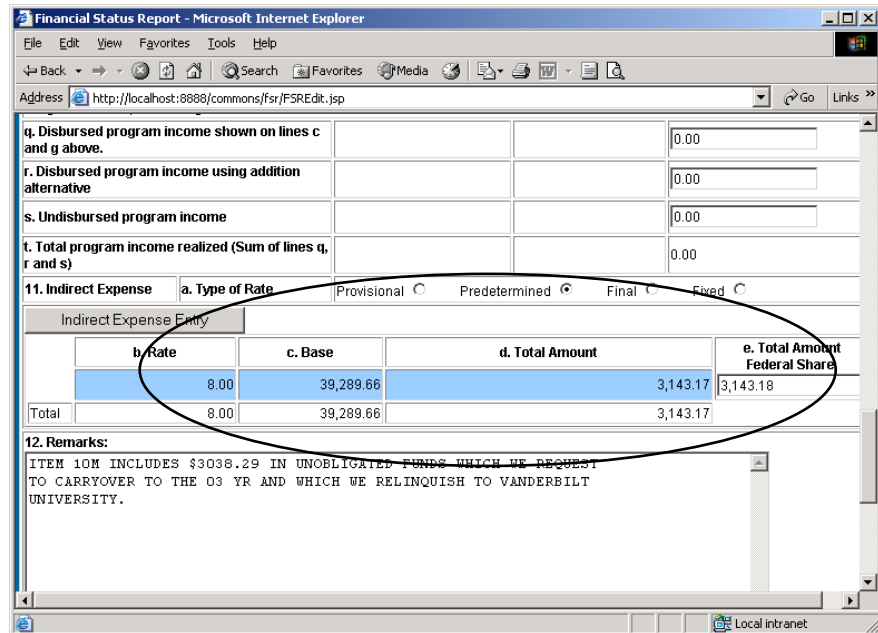


Figure 1. 3 FSR Edit Screen (FSR8005).
