[This is a maze with true or false statements at each intersection. Answering all of the questions correctly leads the way out of the maze. On a computer, correct answers could add friends to the team at the end, or light up the path on the maze so the friend who's left out can join the group of very cool and healthy teens.]

True Statements

False Statements

You can tell someone is infected with HIV by looking at them.

There is a vaccine that prevents HIV infection.
