Conflict of Interest Disclosure Statement***

The Advisory Board on Radiation and Worker Health (the Board) is very concerned with maintaining the transparency of the compensation program created by the Energy Employees Occupational Illness Compensation Program Act of 2000. In an effort to foster a fully open and honest environment for claimants and in order to allay any concerns within the stakeholder community regarding perceived or actual conflicts of interest for Board members, the Board releases the following information:

Biographical Information: Mr. Clawson has been a Senior Operator in the Spent Nuclear fuels program at the Idaho National Laboratory (INL) since 1989. He has been involved in the shipping and receiving of the Nuclear Naval fuels, the recovery and storage of the Three Mile Island fuel, and received and stored Foreign Research Reactor fuels, and numerous other types of nuclear fuels. In addition, he serves as the Nuclear Material Custodian for INL. Mr. Clawson is involved in troubleshooting and problem solving for daily problems and resolution of fuel handling, as well as the design and fabrication of tools for the ongoing inventory of the fuels. He is a member of the United Steelworkers Union Local 8-652, where he also holds several offices. Mr. Clawson is the former Secretary-Treasurer of the PACE USW Atomic Energy Workers Council.

Waiver: Mr. Clawson has been provided a waiver under 18 U.S.C. § 208(b)(3), permitting him to participate in the deliberations and recommendations of the Board, because the need for his services outweighs the potential for conflict of interest. This waiver is expressly limited as described below, and will not allow participation relating to specific matters in which he has a financial or imputed financial interest. In addition, Mr. Clawson will remain subject to the disqualification requirements imposed by 5 C.F.R. § 2635.502 with respect to specific party matters. Each individual Board member, with the assistance and guidance of the Designated Federal Official, will monitor all Board issues for other actual or potential conflicts of interest and will ensure proper recusal if necessary.
