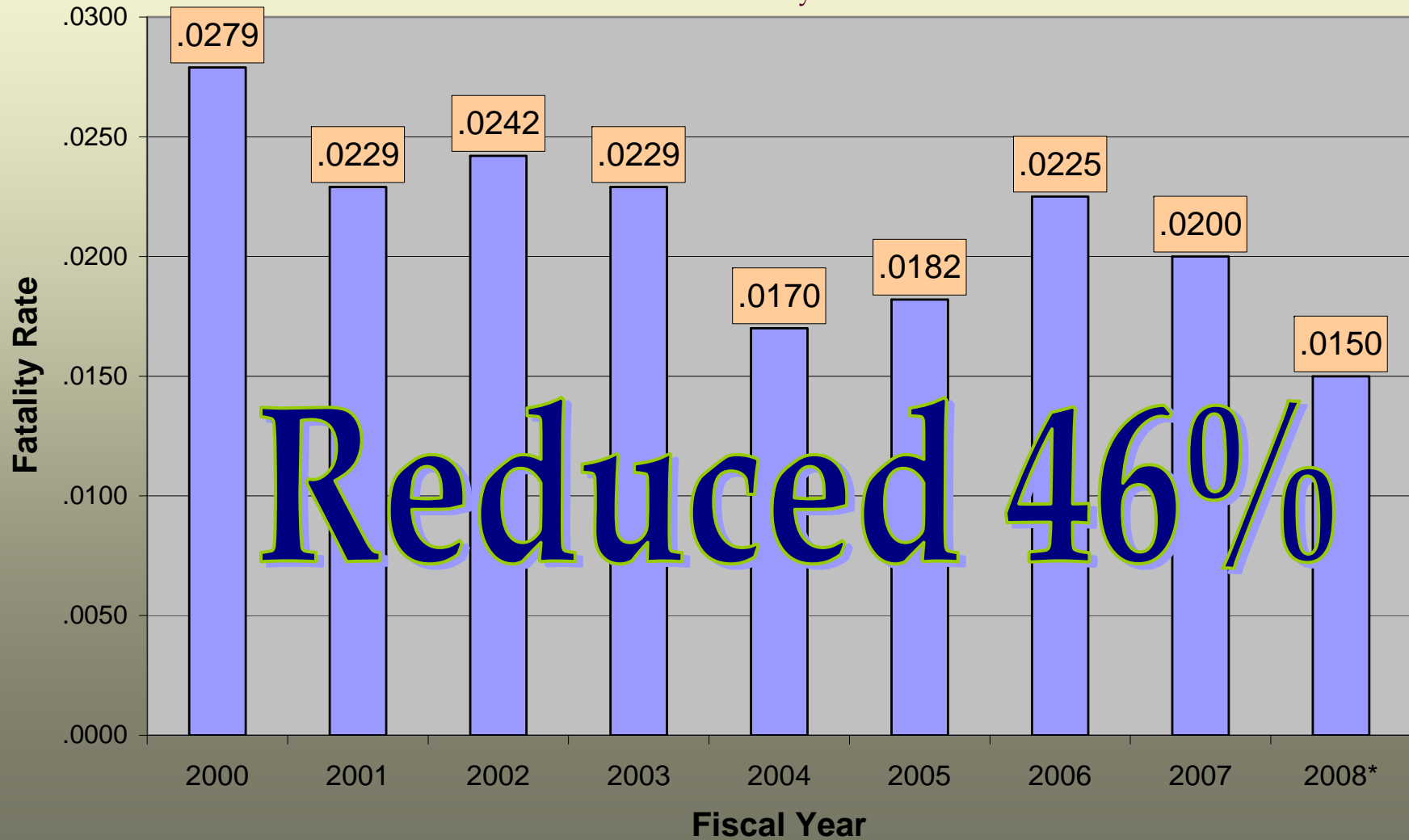

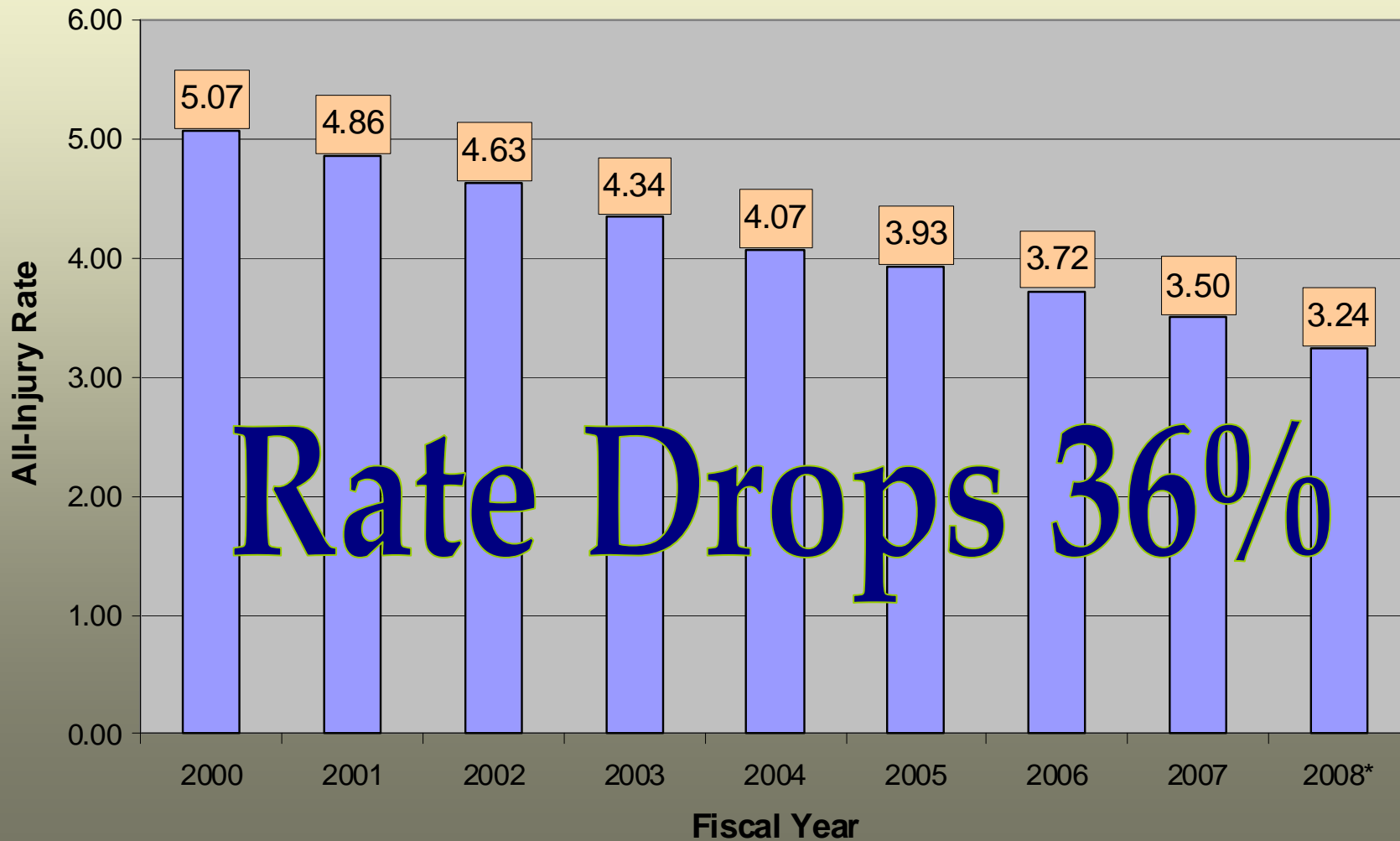
# All Mining Fatality Rate

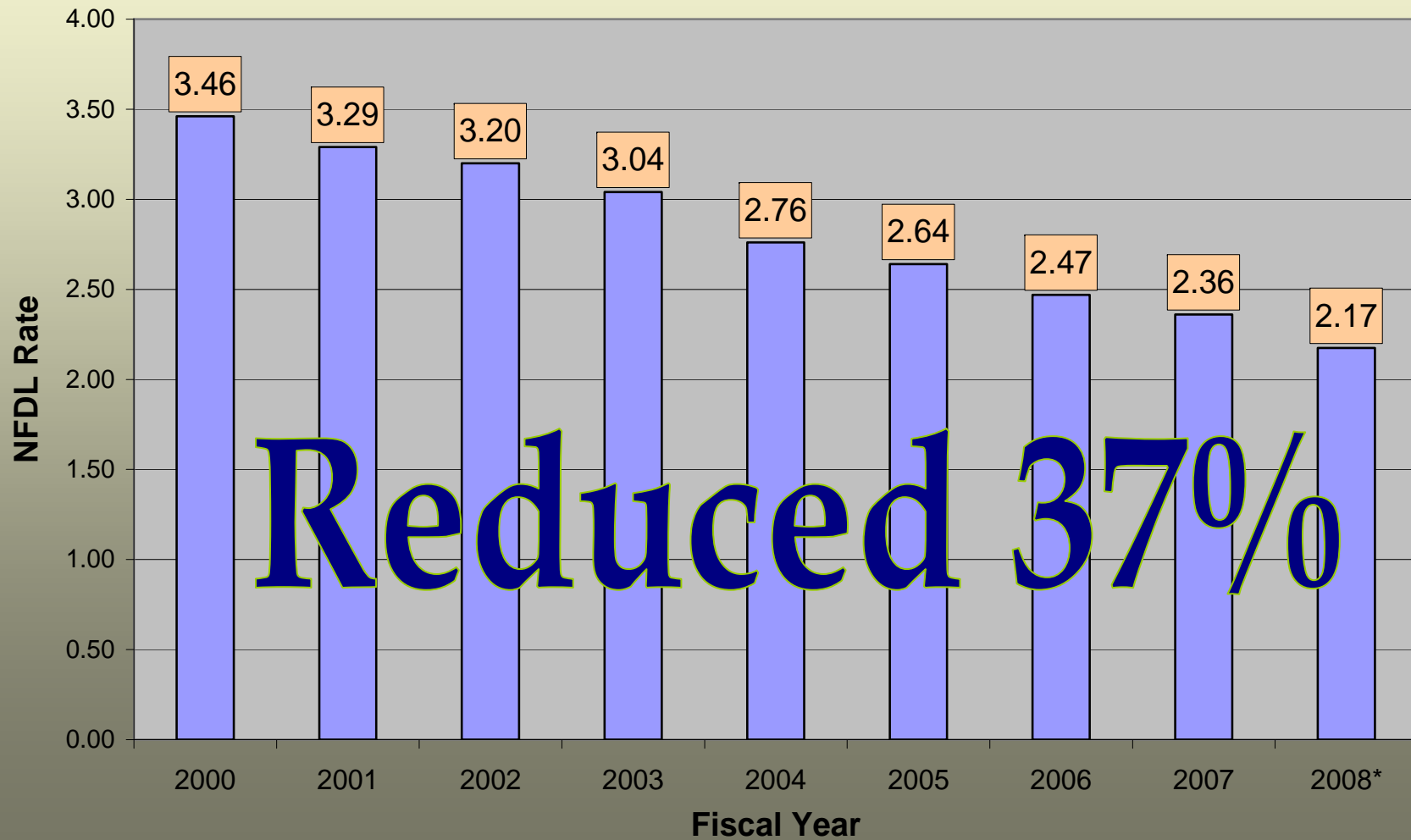
# All Mining All-Injury Rate

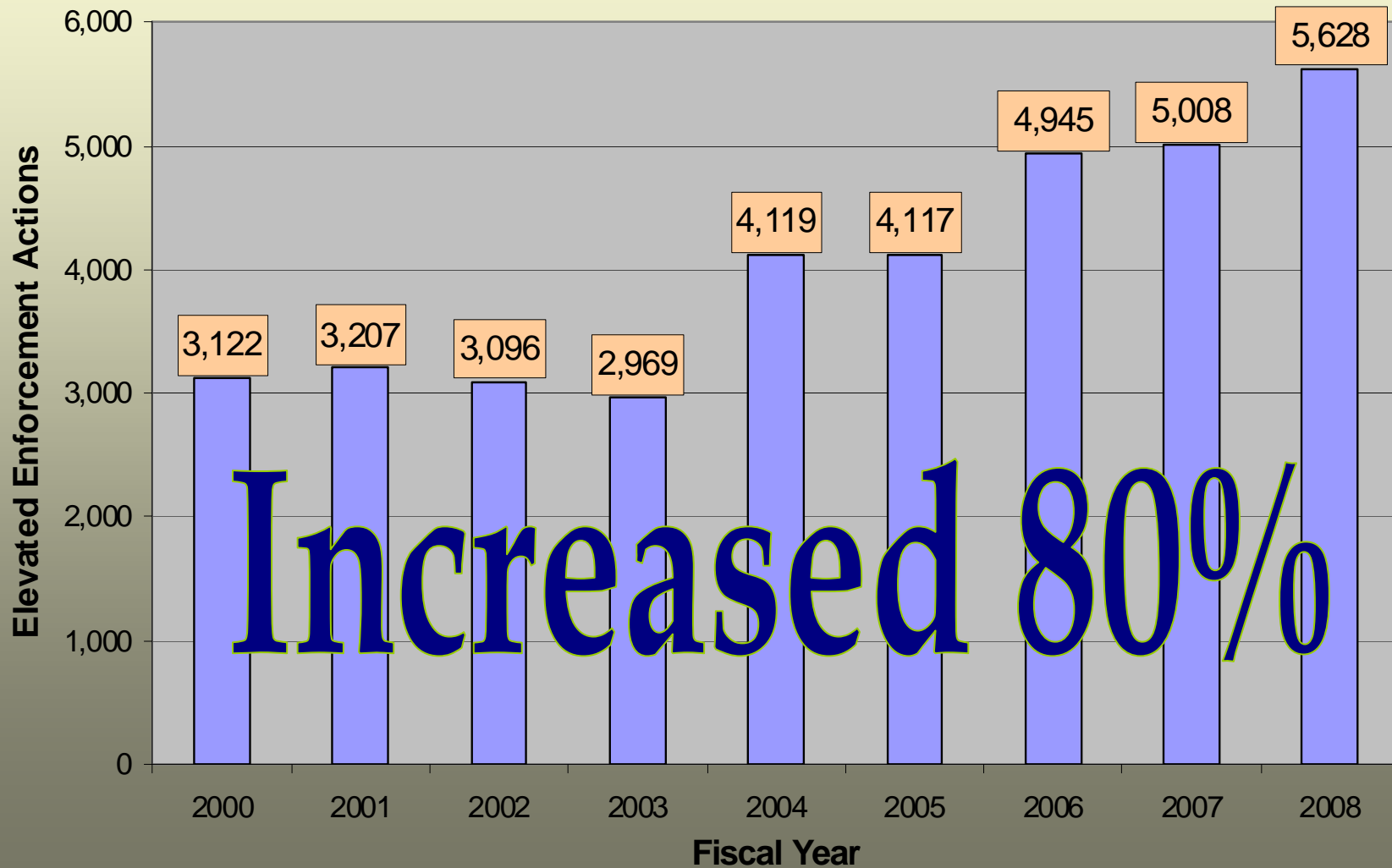


# All Mines Non-Fatal Days Lost Injury Rate

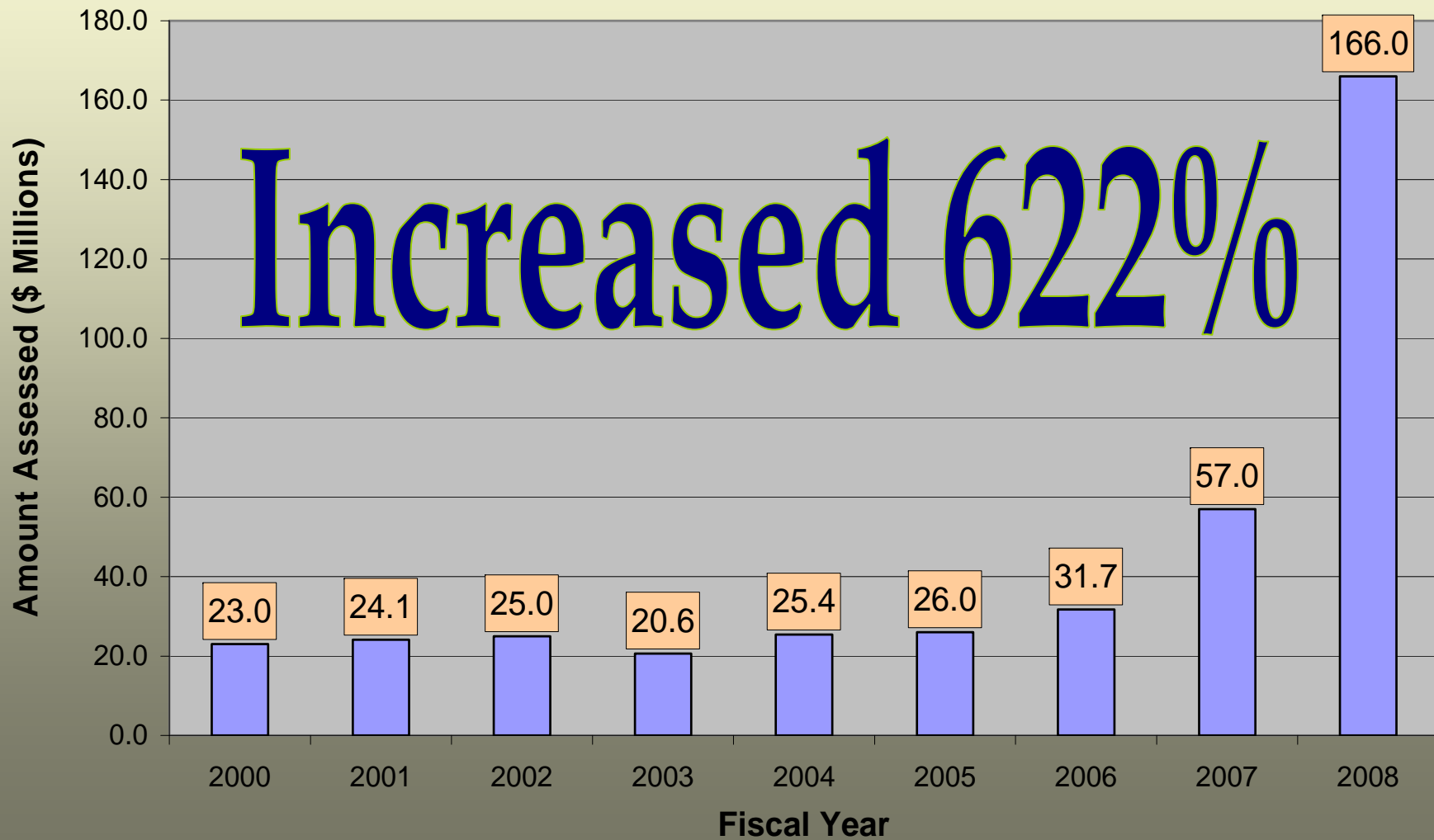

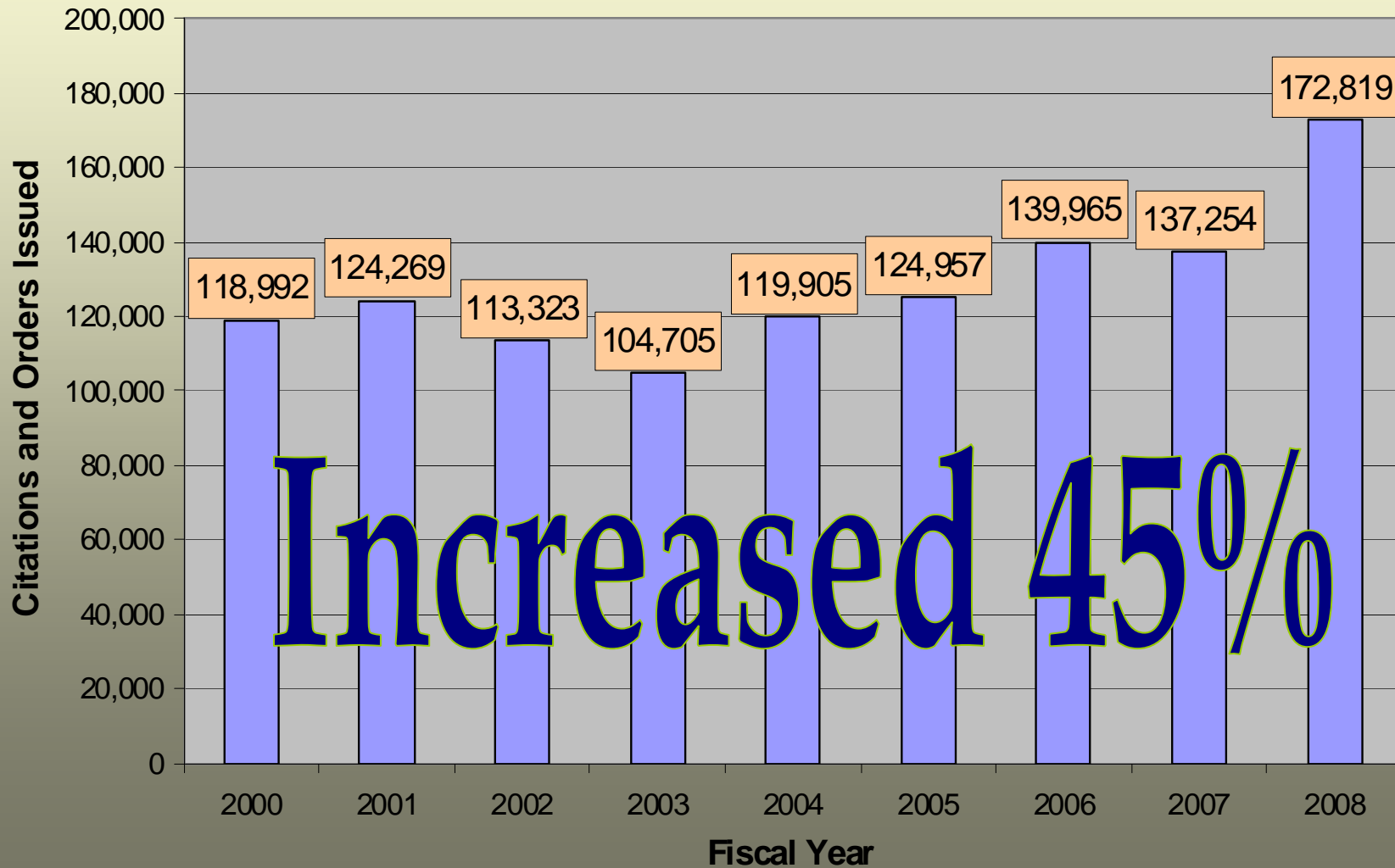

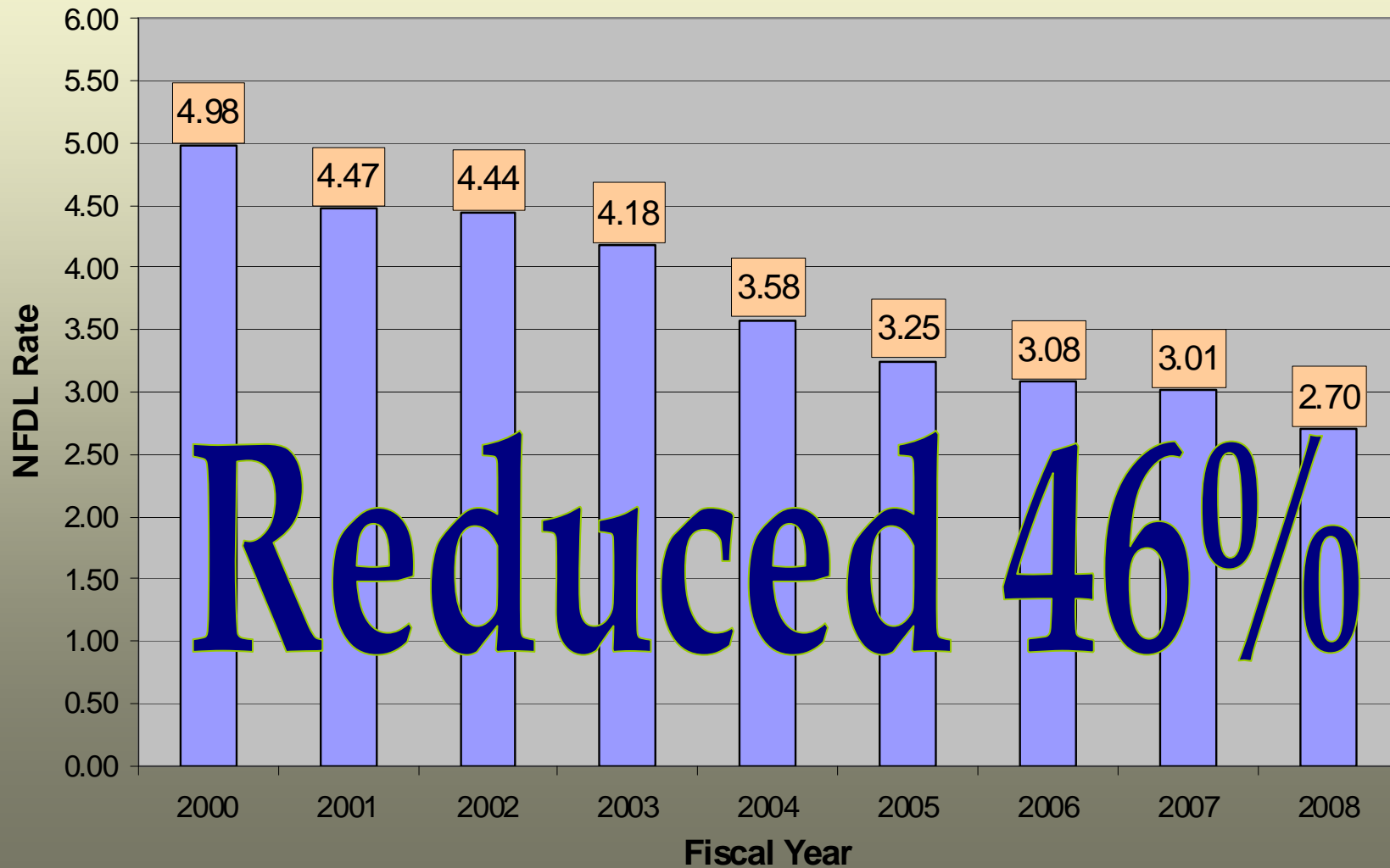

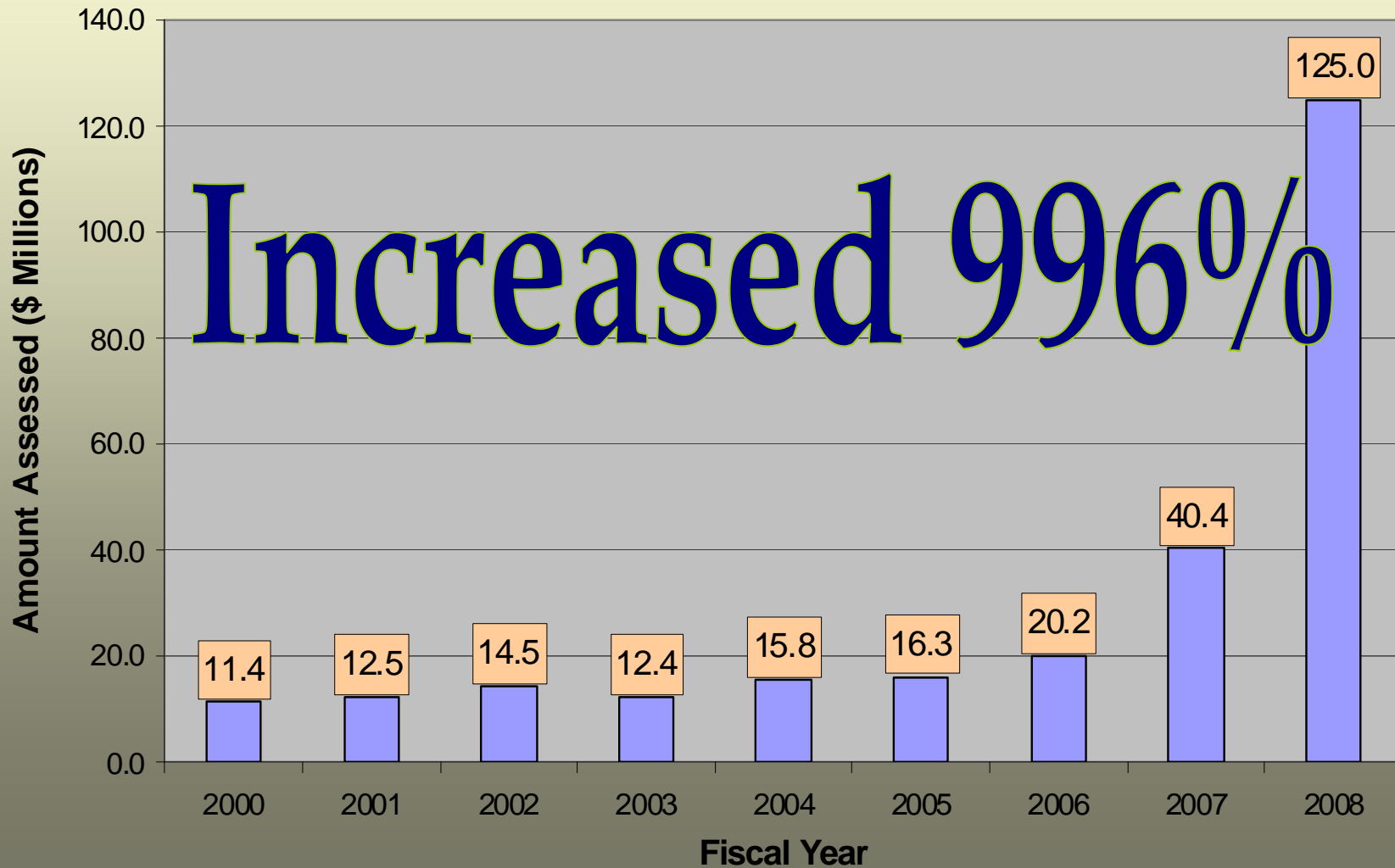

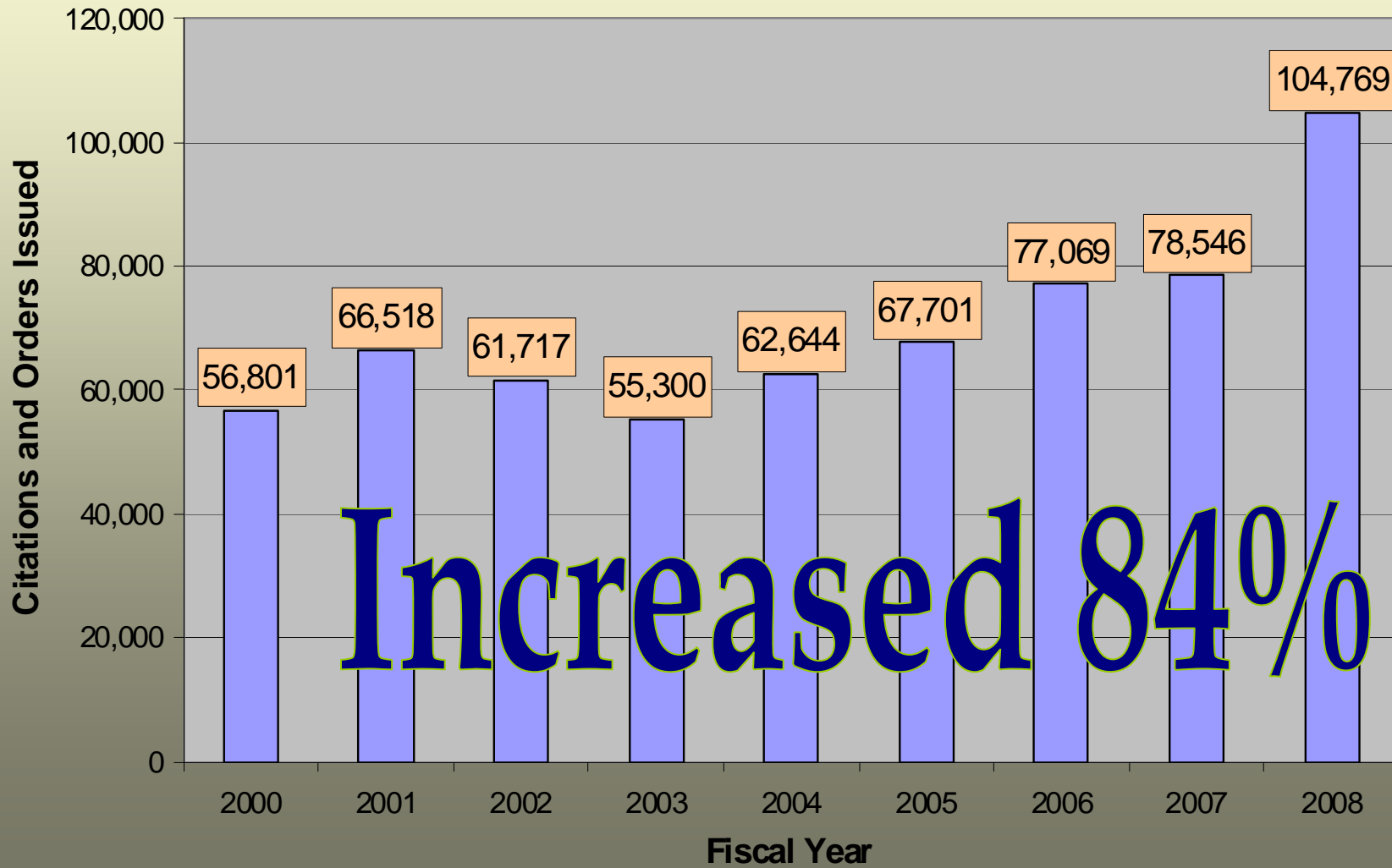

# Coal Enforcement FY 2008 vs. 2007

- Completed 100% of inspections
- 12% increase in regular inspections
- 46% increase in inspection hours
- 33% increase in citations and orders
- 209% increase in assessed penalties



# New Coal Mine Inspectors

- MSHA's goal: 757 FTE coal inspectors
- 360 new inspectors hired since July 2006
- Net gain of 169 full time coal inspectors
- Total coal inspectors nationwide: 754



# Coal Mining Summary

## FY 2000-2008

- Fatality Rate reduced 29%
- All-Injury Rate reduced 41%
- Non-Fatal Days Lost Injury Rate reduced 46%
- Dollar Amount Assessed increased 996%
- Citations and Orders increased 84%
- Elevated Enforcement Actions up 171%

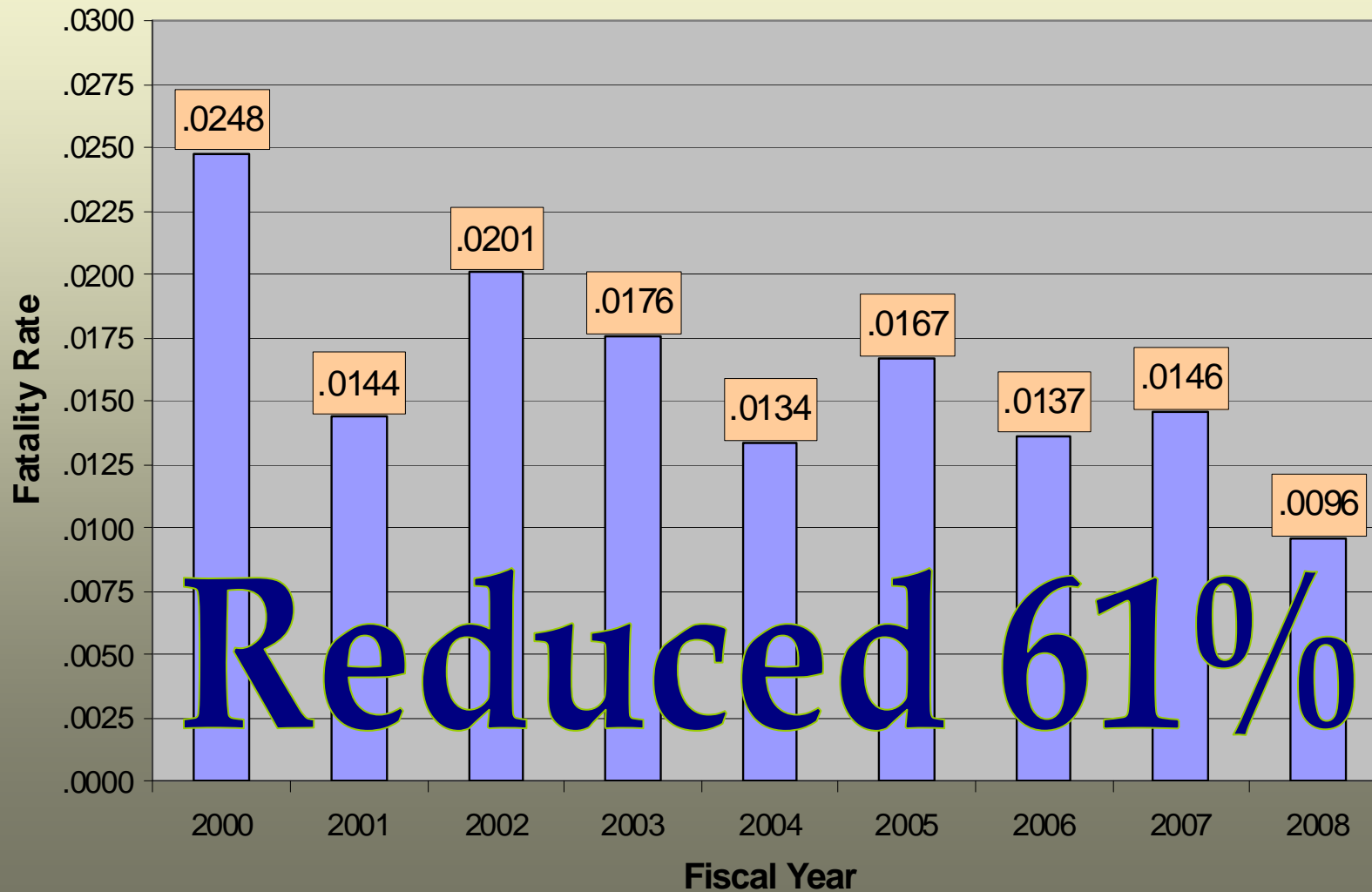

Percent Comparison - 2000-2008***

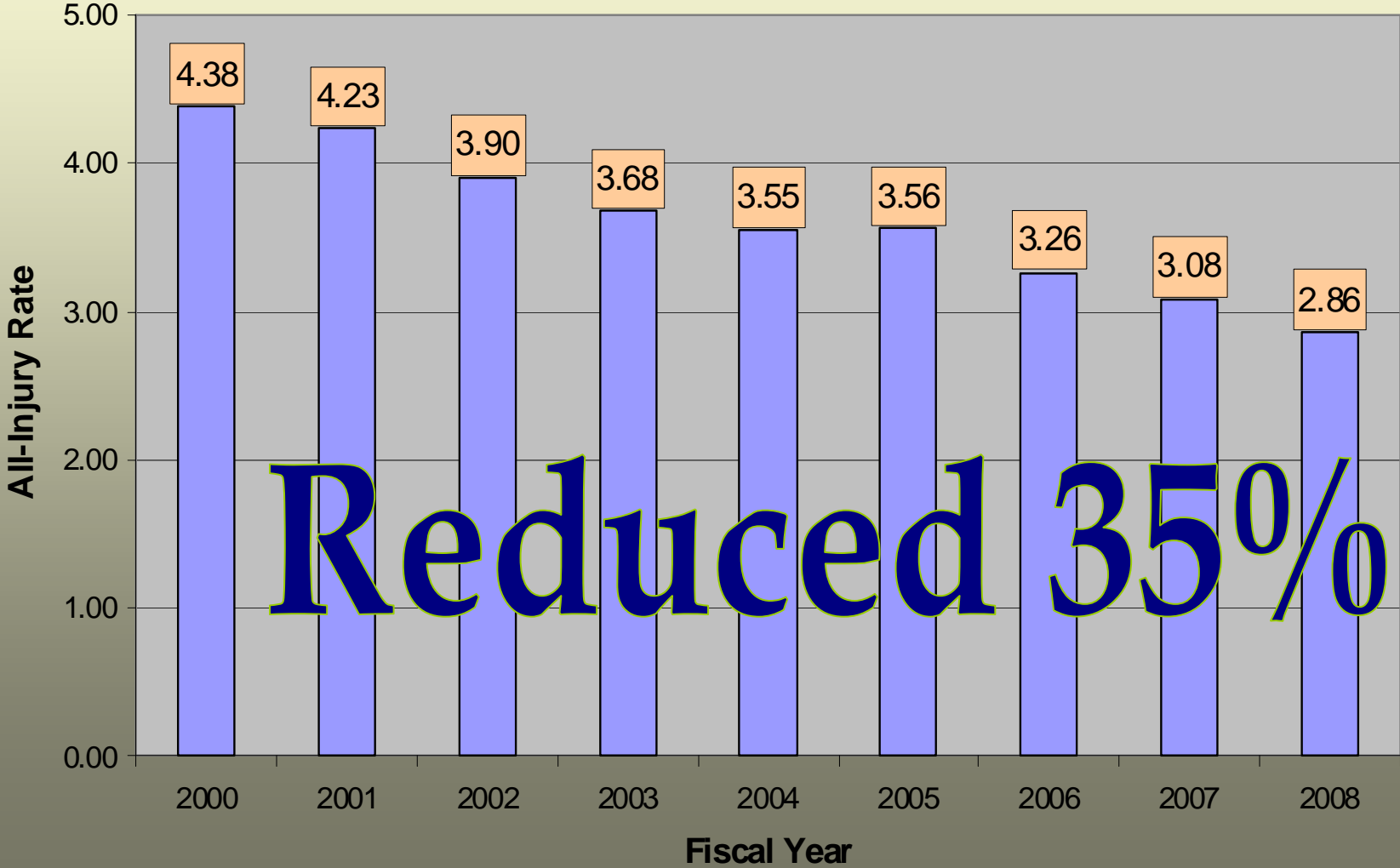
# Metal/Non-Metal Fatality Rate

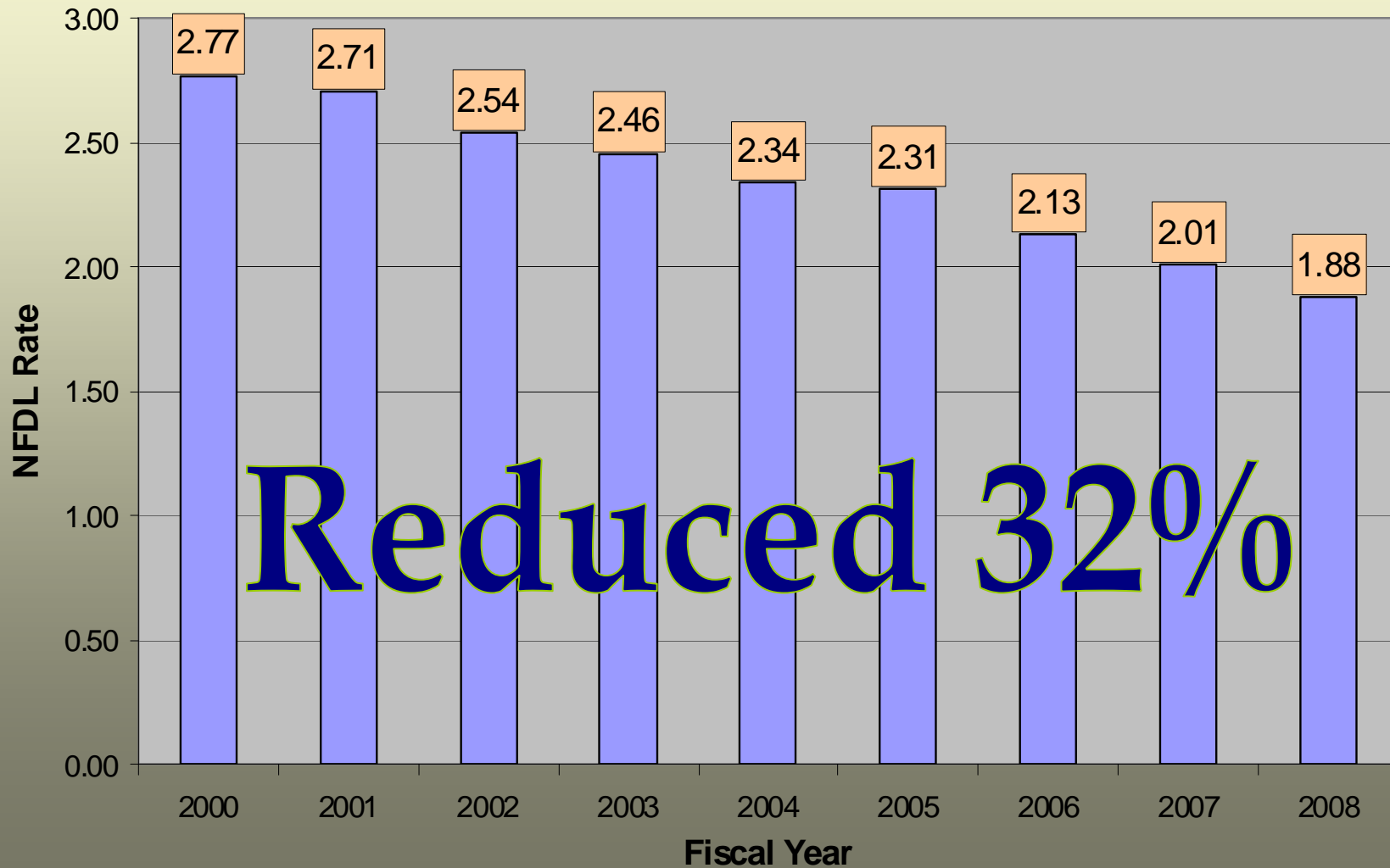
# Metal/Non-Metal All-Injury Rate

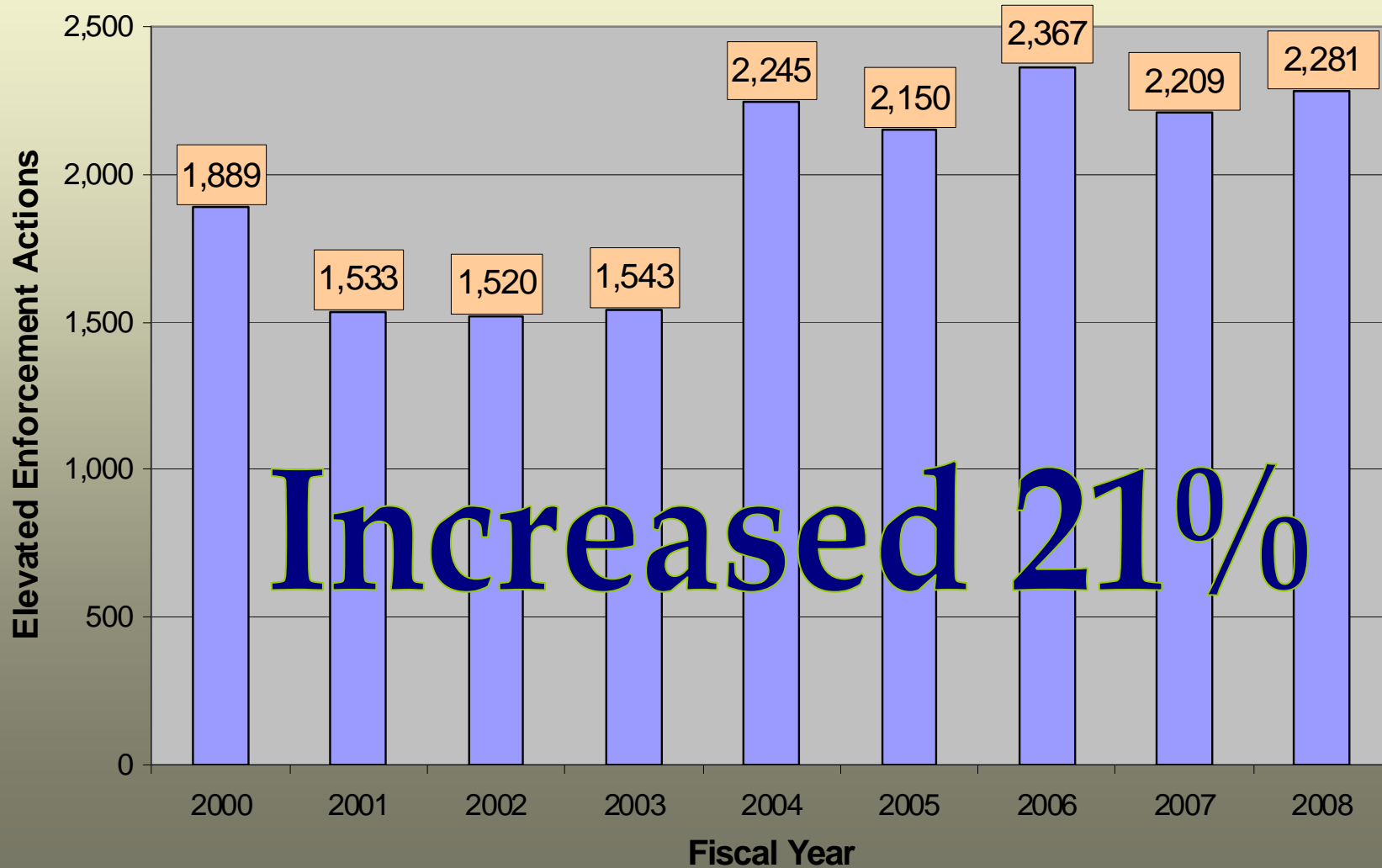


# Metal/Non-Metal Non-Fatal Days Lost Injury Rate

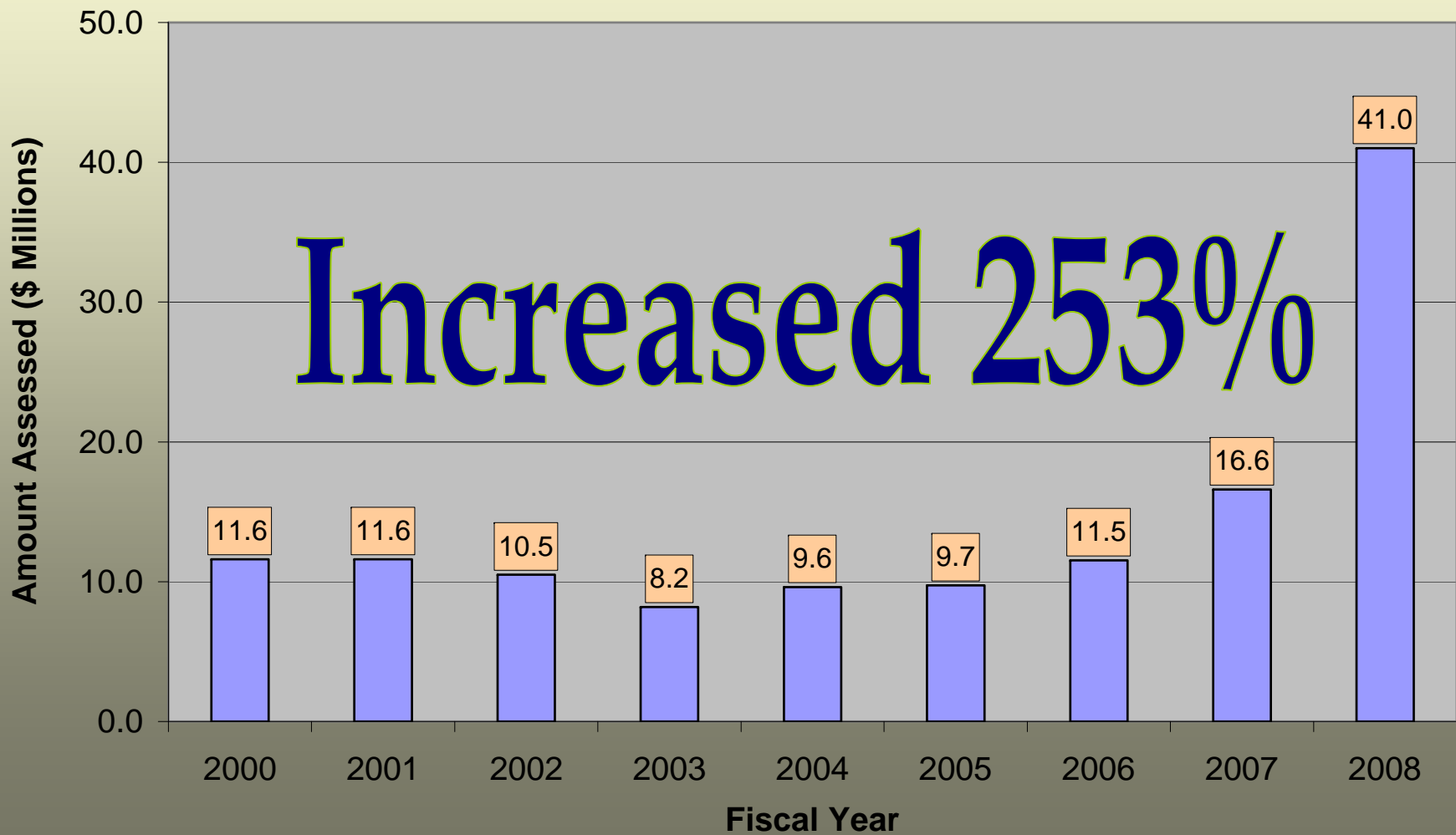

# Metal/Non-Metal Elevated Enforcement Actions

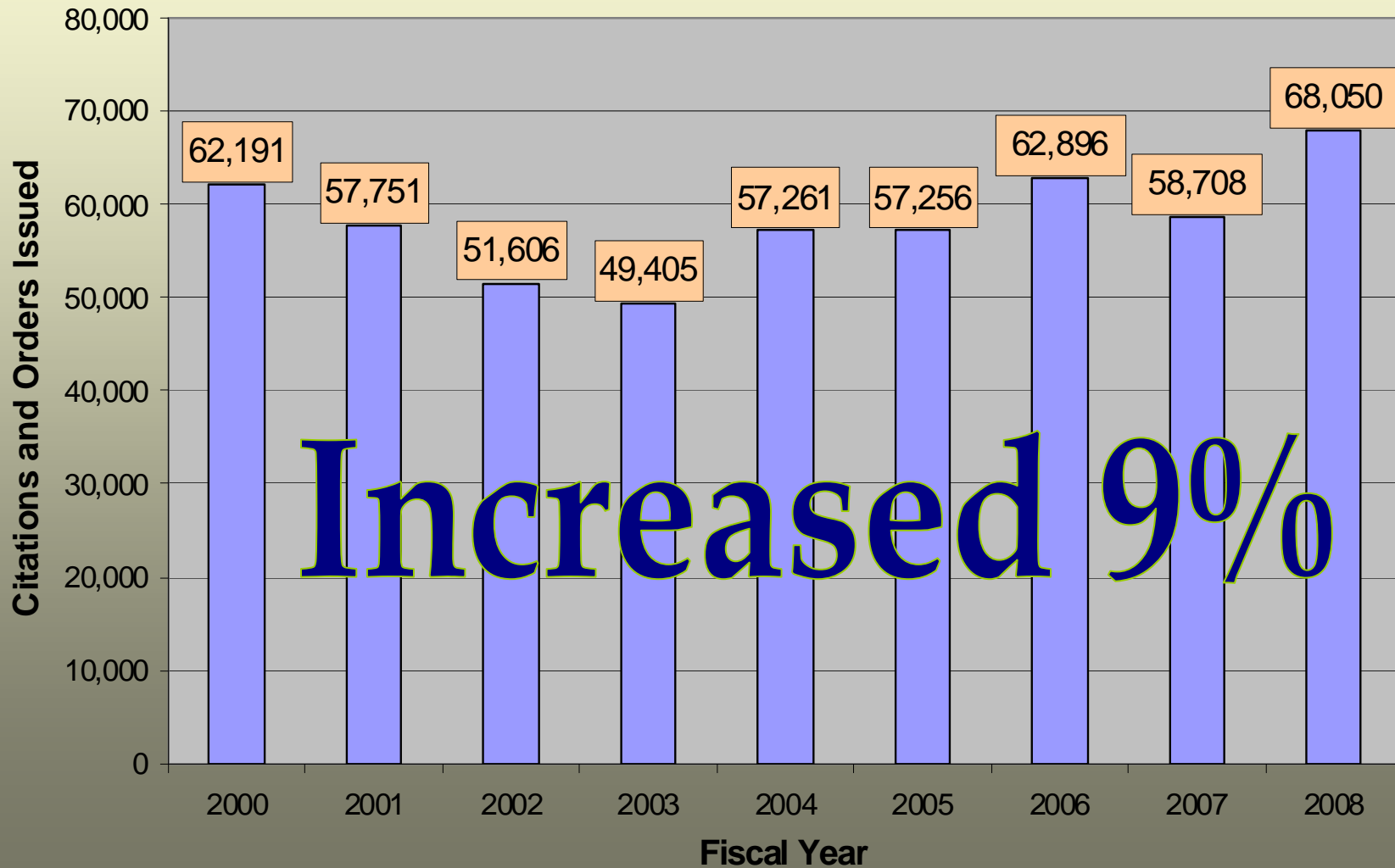


# Metal/Non-Metal Dollar Amount Assessed

# **Metal/Non-Metal Enforcement FY 2008 vs. 2007**

- Completed 100% of inspections
- 14% increase in regular inspections
- 13% increase in inspection hours
- 16% increase in citations and orders
- 147% increase in assessed penalties

# **Metal/Non-Metal Mining Summary**

## **FY 2000-2008**

- Fatality Rate reduced 61%
- All-Injury Rate reduced 35%
- Non-Fatal Days Lost Injury Rate reduced 32%
- Dollar Amount Assessed increased 253%
- Elevated Enforcement Actions increased 21 %
- Citations and Orders increased 9%

# **All Mining Summary FY 2000-2008**

- **Fatality Rate reduced 46%**
