SUBJECT: Introductory Ethics Courses offered in Washington, DC

INTRODUCTORY COURSE DESCRIPTIONS:

The OGE Form 450 Review course is designed for ethics officials who have responsibility for reviewing the OGE Form 450 and advising employees about financial disclosure.

The Misuse of Position course provides a broad overview of Subpart G and includes a four-step approach to determine whether proposed actions are prohibited by the misuse subpart.
