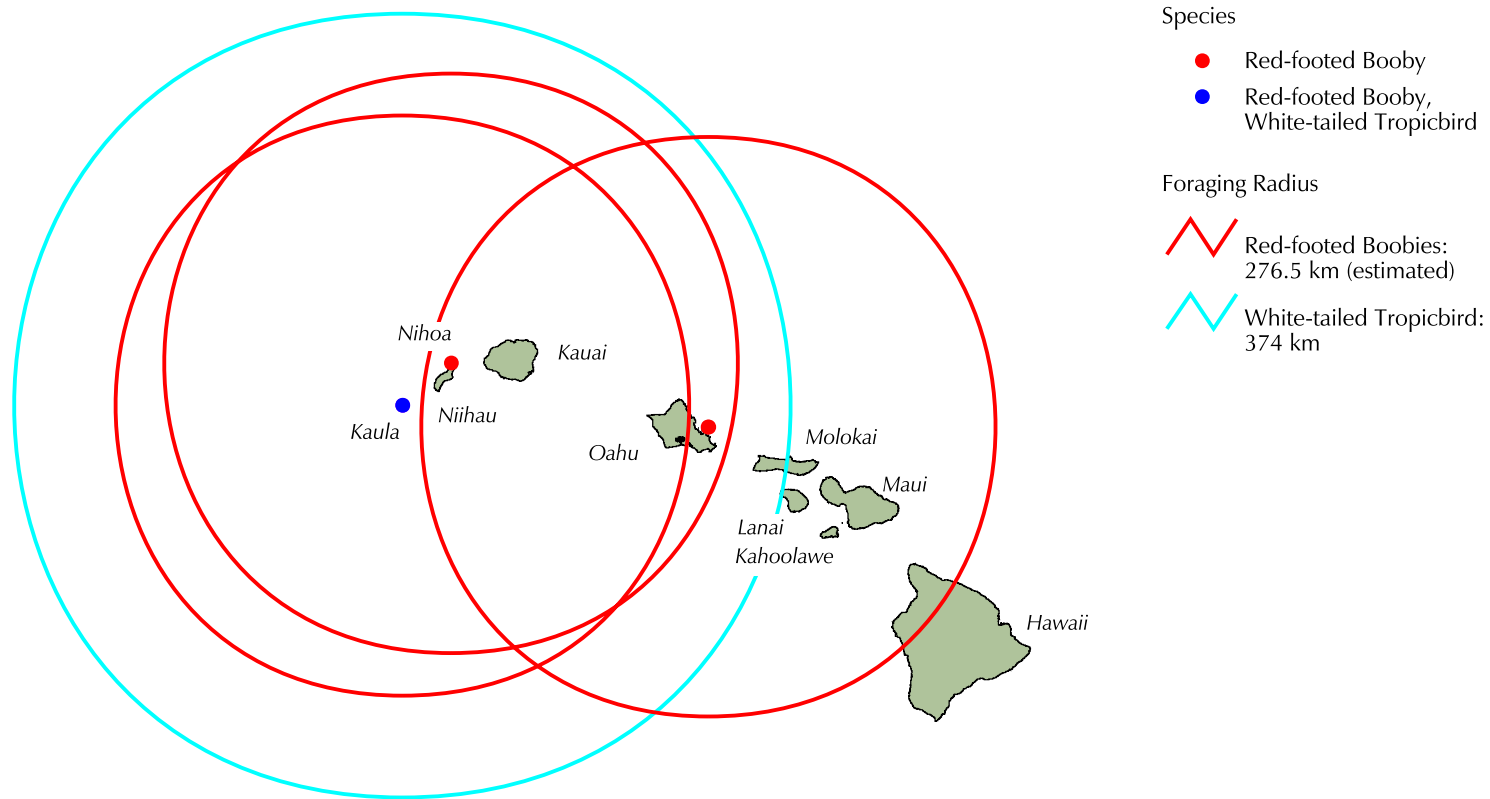

Estimated foraging range of seabirds oiled in the Tesoro Oil Spill Hawaii, 24 August 1998

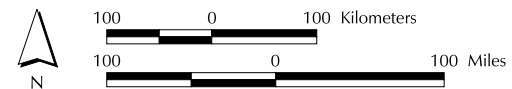
