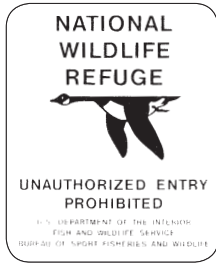


Refuge Signs - Know Their Meaning!



Boundary Sign
Hunting is authorized in designated areas during the regular deer firearms season. Consult the refuge manager for current regulations.



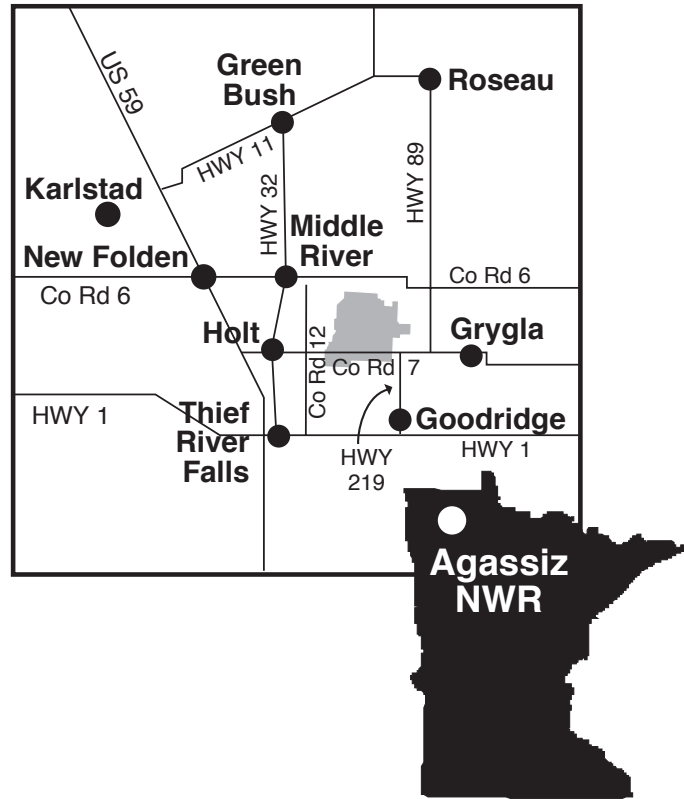
Do Not Block Gate
Do not park in front of gate. Access needed by refuge personnel.



Sanctuary Area
This area is off-limits to the public.

Hunting Regulations

- The refuge is open only to deer hunting during the regular firearms season in accordance with all applicable State, Federal and refuge regulations, and as posted.
- All other wildlife species are protected and may not be killed.
- Vehicles and hunters may not enter the refuge before 5:30 a.m. and must leave the refuge each day as soon as possible after the legal hunting time. Gates open at 5:30 a.m. and close when all hunters have left.
- Motorized vehicles must remain on designated open roads and parking areas.
- Portable stands only.
- All blinds, platforms, scaffolds and steps must be temporary and removed daily.
- Bicycles are permitted on all roads and trails in areas open to deer hunting.
- Use of wheeled non-motorized game retrieval carts may be used except in the Wilderness Area.;
- Use of non-motorized boats/canoes permitted.
- All injuries or accidents occurring on the refuge must be reported immediately to the Refuge Headquarters.
- Shooting from gravel road surface.
- Entry into the closed area for any reason is prohibited.
- Parking, blocking, or in any manner restricting access to roads and gates.
- Use of Snowmobiles and ATVs.
- Target, skeet, trap and indiscriminate shooting.
- Use or possession of alcoholic beverages while hunting.
- Overnight camping, parking and open fires. Primitive camping is available in designated areas on nearby State Wildlife Management Areas.
