


Building ERA: Ensuring we get a system that works correctly

- Focus is on <u>satisfying ERA requirements</u> and ensuring that the system <u>meets the needs</u> of those who will use it
- A gradual approach to reaching IOC: Sep 07 Mar 08
- A six-month Pilot in three Drops <u>Testing</u> activities only
 - ✓ Drop 1: Oct Nov
 - √ Drop 2: Dec Feb
 - ✓ Drop 3: Jan March

Goals for Testing the Pilot

- Ensure that the system satisfies user
 requirements, expectations, and acceptance
- Identify discrepancies and limitations
- Demonstrate system capabilities
- Ensure security controls and vulnerabilities
- Dry Runs for each Drop
