CEQ was unable to submit draft FOIA regulations to Federal Register in December of 2006 due, at least in part, to its inability to replace a key staff member who retired from Federal service at the end of July, 2006. Since publishing a Vacancy Announcement for a Paralegal Specialist on August 17, 2006, and again January 23, 2007, CEQ has hired a replacement staff member whose employment began May 7<sup>th</sup> 2007.

CEQ plans to fully implement its FOIA Plan by submitting draft FOIA regulations to the Federal Register in December 2007.
