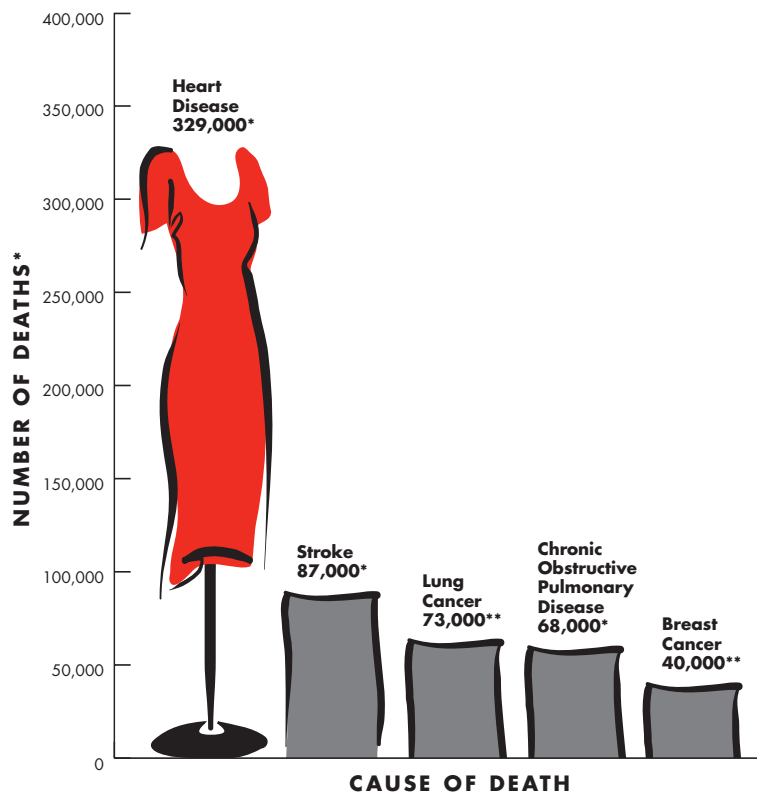


LEADING CAUSES OF DEATH FOR AMERICAN WOMEN (2005)
