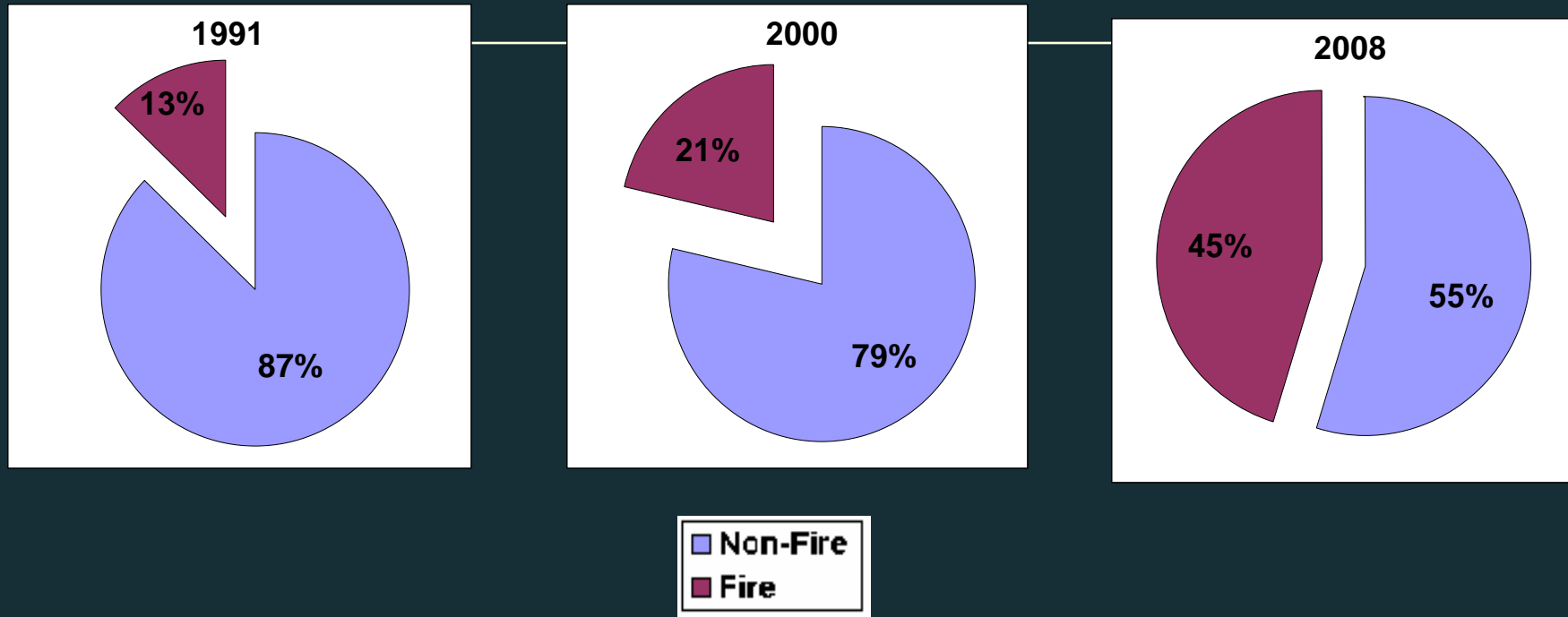


# Fire/Non-fire Budget Relationship
