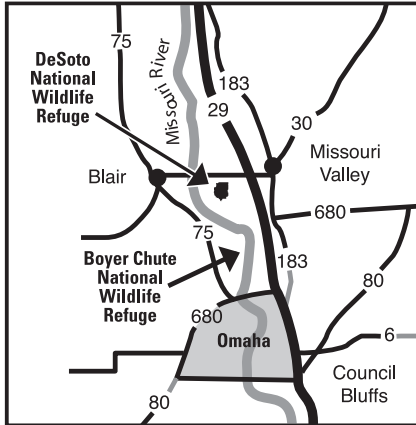
Entry Fee Required Universally Accessible
