# *Necedah National Wildlife Refuge Public Use Regulations*



**Necedah is open from sunrise to sunset.**

**The Refuge office is open Monday-Friday, 7:30 a.m. - 4:00 p.m.**



Speed limit is 25 mph unless otherwise posted.



Parking is permitted in designated areas. Do not block gates.



Vehicles, ATV's, snowmobiles, bicycling and horseback riding are not permitted off township roads.



Open fires and charcoal fires are not permitted on the refuge.



Collecting berries is allowed July 1 through August 15. Collecting natural items such as plants, animals, antlers and objects of antiquity is prohibited.



Camping is not permitted on the refuge.



Pets must be leashed at all times.
