Dear Ms. Salas:

Thank you for your letter requesting a list of threatened or endangered species occurring in the area associated with the Falls Creek Hydrologic Project (Project No. 11659-001). The National Marine Fisheries Service (NMFS) is responsible for certain marine species listed under the Endangered Species Act of 1973, as amended (ESA). Of these, only the humpback whale, Megaptera novaeangliae, and the Steller sea lion, Eumetopias jubatus, would be expected to occur in the areas potentially affected by this project. These species are found throughout the waters of southeast Alaska, including Glacier Bay. No critical habitat for either species is found in the project areas.

Under Section 7 of the ESA, a Federal agency is required to consult with the Secretary of Commerce regarding the presence of these species. If this presence is identified, the agency must then determine if the activity may affect these animals or their habitats. If it finds the action would not affect these concerns, no further consultation is required. Otherwise, the action agency should notify NMFS of its findings and request consultation under the Act.
