Dear Mr. Heppner,

Thank you for providing The National Marine Fisheries Service (NMFS) with revised standard operating procedures (SOPS) to address essential fish habitat (EFH) consultation regarding the Native Allotment Fire Management Plan (FMP) draft EA. The revisions to the SOPS will eliminate surface activity, including the use of mechanical/chemical treatments within 100 feet of a riparian or wetland zone and prohibit the use of non-native plant species for rehabilitation of burned land. Based on the incorporation of these SOPS, NMFS agrees that the project is unlikely to adversely affect EFH.
