Thank you for inviting the National Marine Fisheries Service (NMFS) to assume cooperating agency status under the National Environmental Policy Act for the referenced SEIS. NMFS appreciates your recognition of areas under our expertise as important for analyses of potential marine resource impacts from the project. However, we decline the invitation because cooperating agency status is unnecessary for our successful collaboration on the project. We wish to assure the Tongass National Forest that NMFS will cooperate to the fullest extent possible to facilitate development of the SEIS and adequate consideration of resources under our jurisdiction. We will participate actively in the Interdisciplinary Team, adhere to the SEIS review schedule, suggest potential mitigation measures and alternatives related to marine transportation and aquatic resources, and include the Forest Service in any pertinent meetings with Coeur Alaska.
