The National Martine Fisheries Service (NMFS) has reviewed your letter concerning replacement and improvements to sheet piling near Nome, Alaska. Your letter states that the Corps of Engineers has determined this proposed work is not likely to adversely impact threatened or endangered species.

We consider the Corps' determination to have been made under informal procedures of the Endangered Species Act, as described at 50 CFR 402.13. Our agency concurs with your determinations regarding threatened and endangered species and their critical habitat, because the proposed actions and alternatives are not likely to adversely affect endangered bowhead whales. Therefore, we consider the requirements of section 7 (a)(2) of the ESA have been met and no further consultation is required.
