

USDA's Office of the Chief Financial Officer Receives Veteran's Administration Small Business Award for Contracting Achievements with Service Disabled Veteran-Owned Small Business. USDA's Office of the Chief Financial Officer (OCFO) received an achievement award for its efforts to contract with Service Disabled Veteran-Owned Small Businesses (SDVOSB) from the Center for Veterans Enterprise, Veterans Administration (VA), June 2006, during VA's 5<sup>th</sup> Annual Awards Ceremony. During fiscal year 2005, OCFO's National Finance Center (NFC) far exceeded the 3 percent goal for contracts awarded to SDVOSB.
