



Preserve America Summit Implementation
One-Year Progress Report

Address security needs by developing guidance, including guidance on all-hazards risk assessment.

Lead Agency/Agencies: General Services Administration, Department of the Interior, Department of Defense, Department of Homeland Security

Summit Recommendation Progress: The team's task is to develop and implement a method of keeping and sharing existing guidance, information, and best practices for the integration of historic preservation and security requirements for buildings, cultural sites, and physical property, in general. The team is working with the existing Historic Preservation Learning Portal maintained by the National Park Service (NPS) to house the Addressing Security Needs Clearinghouse. The Addressing Security Needs Bibliography developed by the Department of Defense-chaired Preserve America Summit panel has been added to the Portal in the Federal Preservation Institute (FPI) Bookshelf.

Next Actions: The implementation team is working with NPS/FPI to identify a more permanent and prominent location for the information on the site. Upgrades to the Portal will be completed in Fall 2008.
