1:00:00:00	Tornado A3, 5:28 – first strong tornado on the Oklahoma City storm; tracked from between Apache & Cyril toward Anadarko, Okla. Later rated an F3 by NOAA National Weather Service survey teams. Funnel cloud mentioned at 1:01:34:00 is the formation of tornado A4 to the East; Clip duration 2:01
1:02:01:00	Tornado A6 as it passed by Chickasha; Clip duration :17
1:02:20:00	Tornado B10 near Minco, OK; Clip Duration :42
1:03:03:00	Tornadoes A6, A7 (satellite tornado), 6:07 PM near Laverly, Okla. Clip Duration :13
1:03:17:00	Tornadoes A6, A7, 6:08 PM Same as above, better view; Clip Duration :09
