

Visiting IFS in Stockholm

From Arlanda Airport:

Take the train (under the airport terminal) or the bus (outside the airport terminal) to the city - arriving at Central Station or City Bus Terminal respectively. Then follow the information below.

Getting to IFS from Stockholm's Central Railway Station or City Bus Terminal:

Walking:

A nice walk along the water takes about 45 minutes - see the dotted blue line on the map.

By Metro:

Take the red Metro line in the direction of Ropsten 2 stops from T-Centralen (at Central Station) to Karlaplan. Turn left into Karlavägen as you exit from the Metro, walk about 100 meters to no.108. Tickets can be bought at the entrance to the platforms. You can buy a card of 20 tickets (called a 'rabatt-häfte') - each journey in the inner city needs 2 tickets.

By Taxi:

There are taxis waiting outside both the bus terminal and Central Station.

Buses:

Bus 4 (blue bus)
The end station (Radiohuset) is outside the door of IFS. Suitable if you are coming from:
Gullmarsplan

Söder Fridhemsplan Odenplan

Bus 76 from Segelstorg (near Sida) - get out at Radiohuset



Stockholm's Metro (Tunnelbana) and suburban train lines (Pendeltåg)

IFS is near Karlaplan, the second stop from T-Centralen on the red line (Metro), in the direction of Ropsten.

The grey and white areas show the zones - the ticket price increases only as you cross to another zone. The whole inner city is in zone 1.
