Order Granting Respondents Raines' and Spencer's Motions to Withdraw As Moot Motion for Stay and Interlocutory Review

Respondents Raines and Spencer filed, in separate motions, Motions for Interlocutory Review of this Court's May 25, 2007 Order Regarding Respondents' Motions to Strike OFHEO's Second Set of Document Requests. Thereafter, on June 26, 2007, Respondent Raines moved to withdraw his motion for interlocutory review and, on June 27, 2007, Respondent Spencer also sought withdrawal of her motion for interlocutory review.
