

“On February 17, 2009, Your TV is Changing. Are You Ready?”

After February 17, 2009, TV stations will broadcast only in digital. If you watch TV using rabbit ears or a rooftop antenna, you must take action before February 17, 2009.

If you have a new TV with a digital tuner, you can already receive digital broadcasts. Or, if you get your local broadcast channels from a pay service like cable or satellite, digital broadcasting should have no effect on you. If you have any questions, call your provider.

But, if you have an older TV with rabbit ears or rooftop antenna, **you need to act:**

- 1 Connect your TV to a digital-to-analog converter box. **Or**
- 2 Buy a digital television (a TV with a built-in digital tuner). **Or**
- 3 Subscribe to a pay TV service such as cable or satellite.
