CASES CLOSED FEBRUARY 2001

NOTE: This monthly report lists the outcome of secret-ballot voting by employees in NLRB-conducted representation elections as officially certified following resolution of postelection objections and/or challenges. During FY 2001, the NLRB continued to improve its techniques for tracking and collecting case activity data.
