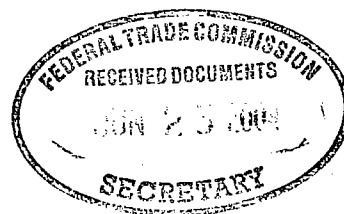



**ORDER APPROVING FIRST JOINT STIPULATION  
REGARDING TRIAL TRANSCRIPT ERRATA**

On June 23, 2004, Complaint Counsel and Respondent North Texas Specialty Physicians filed a joint stipulation regarding trial transcript errata. Pursuant to Commission Rule 3.44(b), corrections of the official transcript may be made when "agreed to in a written stipulation signed by all counsel . . . and approved by the Administrative Law Judge." Pursuant to Commission Rule 3.44(c), the Administrative Law Judge retains the discretion to permit or order such correction of the record after closing the hearing record.

Having reviewed the corrections and found them not to be capricious or without substance, the first joint stipulation regarding trial transcript errata is hereby approved.
