7	"The authority of the Secretary to take any action
8	under this title includes the authority to provide loans,
9	loan guarantees, grants, or other assitance in support of
10	renewable energy projects that have experienced signifi-
11	cant declines in funding attributable to the economic
12	downturn, as determined by the Secretary. The total
13	amount that the Secretary may expend under this section
14	shall be \$5,000,000,000. For purposes of this section, the
15	term 'renewable energy project' means a private business
16	or enterprise where the sole or primary service rendered
17	is related to renewable energy, including solar energy, geo-
8	thermal energy, marine and hydrokinetic renewable energy
9	technologies, energy storage for transportation and elec-
0	tric power, wind energy, advanced biofuel technologies,
